Jump Start, Louisiana's innovative program centering on career readiness, aligns educational goals with the state's economic development strategies. Jump Start prepares students to lead productive adult lives, capable of continuing their education after high school while earning certifications that will create pathways to prosperity upon graduation.

Students pursuing a TOPS Tech Career Diploma, with aspirations for an industry based career, are required to attain industry-valued credentials in order to graduate. However, all Louisiana students, even those on the TOPS University Diploma track are encouraged to obtain industry-based credentials in order to prepare for high-wage, high-demand careers.

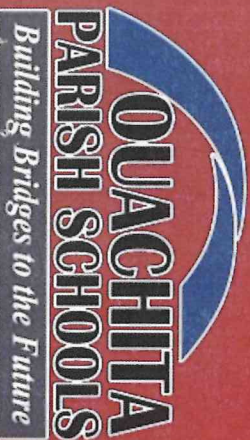

FAQ

"When do I need to choose a diploma pathway?"

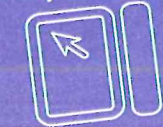
Students must decide during spring of his/her 10th grade year.

"Could I change from a university diploma to the JumpStart diploma or vice versa after spring of the 10th grade year?"

Yes! But in order for a student to earn the remaining credits/credentials, the student may need a 5th year of high school.

"Can I attend a 4 year university if he/she has a JumpStart diploma?"

Yes! You will have to attend a community college first and then transfer to a 4 year university.

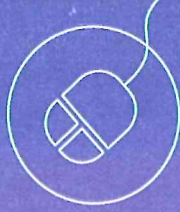


"If I elect to pursue a JumpStart diploma, can I take dual-enrollment classes?"

Yes! Students are strongly encouraged to take dual-enrollment classes.

"Could a university diploma student take a Jump Start class?"

Yes! The Jump Start class would count as an elective.



"Do students need to pass End-of-Course tests to graduate?"

Yes, End-of-Course testing is required for all pathways.

Career Opportunities for YOUR FUTURE

JumpStart Students:

⇒ ATTAIN industry credentials that employers value when deciding who to hire for entry-level positions;

⇒ COMPLETE Career Readiness courses where students master workplace "soft skills" that help them find good jobs and succeed when they report to their first jobs;



⇒ COMPLETE internships (either workplace internships or "virtual workplace experiences") during high school that teach them about the world of work;

⇒ COMPLETE course work that enables Jump Start students to continue their education, through employer training, technical college courses and eventually (if they want) at a four year university.
