I know there is a rubric for qualifying for the alternate ACCESS test; however, our regional compliance representative said that if we have a student on the EXTEND content/testing and they are taking the regular ACCESS test, this could be an issue with that student being on EXTEND content and not justifiable. If the EL teachers have any students that are on EXTEND content but taking regular ACCESS testing, please have them to email Dee Dee and let her know which students this may involve.
