Objectives and Goals

Family Centered Services



Improve communication skills, parenting skills, family dynamics, building support networks, community connections. etc.

Family Group Decision Making



To resolve concerns of and strengthen individual families by working together as one unit.

Independent Living



Learn how to live independently and be self-sufficient through life skills, education, housing, and employment.

Reach Out Mentoring



Link youth to supportive adults in the community and provide a positive relationship to the youth involved.

School Based Outreach
