

The Promise Scholarship

Our mission is to promise our support on your journey to achieve your dreams.

We will provide a scholarship to selected recipients from the EHS Class of 2025 graduates who will advance their educational career through a community, technical, vocational or trade program, apprenticeship or college.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The applicant must:

- graduate from Ephrata High School, June 2025. Running Start students may apply.
- reside in Grant County for a minimum of two years prior to high school graduation.
- have a CUMULATIVE GPA of 2.75 at time of application.
- must be registered and begin program, apprenticeship or college no later than 10/1/2025, if selected.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Complete the application form accurately utilizing technology to complete.
2. Compose a typed, one-page, single-spaced personal statement addressing the following questions:
 - a. How have you prepared yourself for your next steps in your education?
 - b. What impacted your decision to attend your selected post-secondary education choice?
 - c. Share how your post-secondary education/training will impact your future goals
 - d. Why do you think you deserve a Promise Scholarship?
3. Provide TWO recommendations, dated within the current academic year (no later than September 2024) from an authority figure (teacher, coach, employer, etc.) who can share specific details about character, leadership and work ethic.
4. Include a CURRENT OFFICIAL transcript. Provide the most current transcript available, including first semester grades for the committee to accurately evaluate you.

The application deadline is **TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 2025**. Please return application packet and attachments to the EHS Counseling Office. There will be no extensions or exceptions.

POST SELECTION INSTRUCTIONS

Students will be informed of awards at the EHS award ceremony, preceding graduation.

Scholarships are paid directly to the establishment where the student will be attending. Funds will be distributed prior to commencement of Fall 2025 Quarter classes directly to the designated school, provided the student has supplied all necessary forms and information to the Promise Scholarship team no later than August 15, 2025. If student is attending program without quarter/semester system, scholarship will be distributed within 30 days of the program start date.
