Exam Fee: \$68

Students who qualify for the Free/Reduced Lunch program will receive the SAT at a discounted rate.

Who Can Test

• The SAT is usually taken by 11th and 12th graders.

• For the March testing day, 11th graders will have priority.

• Each testing day can have a maximum of 100 students testing, so register early.
