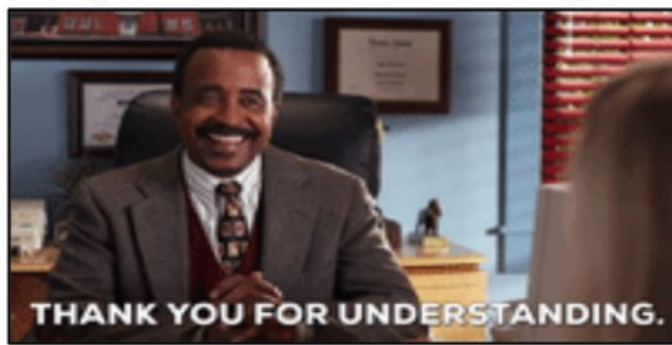
Onesies are permitted only on

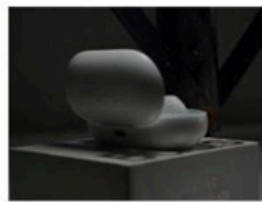
