FULL FUNDING FOR PUBLIC EDUCATION

What are we asking our legislators to do?

- Increase basic allotment.
- Provide inflation adjustment for basic allotment.
- Funding based on enrollment instead of average daily attendance.
- Fully fund all requirements/eliminate unfunded mandates, specifically, security requirements tied to HB 3.
- Provide full credit for local optional homestead exemptions.
- Restore early recapture payment discount.
- Increase education allotments for economically disadvantaged, special education, English learners, gifted and talented, early education, and CTE students.
- Expand funding for full day Pre-K program.
- Continue support for instructional materials through IMAT funding.
