CONGRATULATIONS, MRS. HAMILTON!

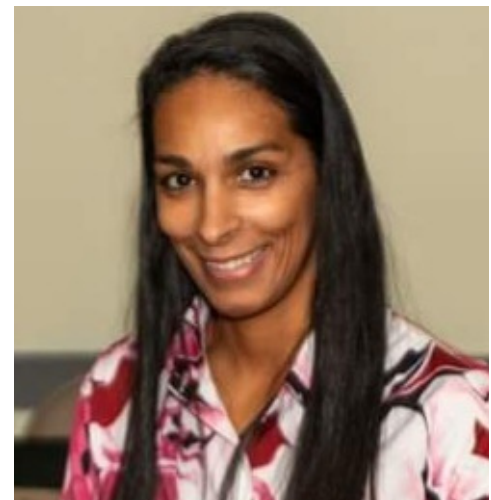
