If the player shows the knowledge and skills to play the game, or the willingness to work hard and learn the game, this will assist in helping the player make the team.

Physicals and Forms:

A Physical and all other forms are to be completed. Once completed, the school will clear the player for the beginning of <u>Summer Tryouts</u>, <u>Practices and for the Season</u>.

- Forms for Physicals and other necessities will be found on the School Website.

No Tryouts or Practices will be attended until the Physical and forms are completed and cleared by school officials

Summer Practices:

- <u>Must first be physically cleared to participate</u> <u>in summer practices and season play (by a</u> <u>doctor)</u>
- June 4th June 27th and July 16th August 8th.
 - June 30th July 14th there will be no practices (per CIF dead period)
- Tuesday, Thursday (3:30- 4:30pm)

If a player is to miss any summer or season practices, they will need to inform the coach.

Girls Golf Season is a "Fall Sport"

We meet and practice throughout the summer and the year. Our Team is available to any student at Burbank High that is interested in playing golf. You will need to attend daily practices and try outs during the summer for our fall sport.

Golf Season Expectations:

(A season-long commitment will be asked from each player which includes Practices, Summer Session, League Play and Playoff season).

- Players will need to miss classes throughout the season for matches that they will be playing.
 - These will be excused absences for school activities. - Any missing homework will be made up by the student
- The player must also maintain a minimum
 2.0 GPA throughout the season and school year.

Attendance, effort, attitude and participation during practice is very important in helping the coaches decide:

- On how much the player will play and also in receiving a grade for golf.
