**Beneficial Society Victor Emmanuel II Scholarships
(For Students of Italian Descent)**

Club Scholarship Eligibility

Applicants must be of Italian descent (by one or both natural parents) and be able to provide documentation to that effect if requested. Applicants must live in Berks County and be a senior at a Berks County High School. Senior applicants attending an alternative education program (Home school, Cyber School, etc.) will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Scholarship Board.

Lodge and Ladies Auxiliary Scholarship Eligibility

Applicants must be direct descendent children and/or grandchildren of current or deceased Lodge and Auxiliary members to be eligible to make application for this scholarship. Eligibility is limited to High School seniors and High School graduates who have not yet attended college and have not been out of high school for more than four years. Senior applicants or graduates that attended an alternate education program (Home School, Cyber School,etc.) will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Scholarship Board.

Additional Eligibility for both Scholarships

Applicants must apply to and be matriculated at an A. Accredited Institution's Bachelor's Degree Program, B. Accredited Institution's Associate Degree Program, C. Acceptable Transfer Program to an Accredited Institution and/or a Professional/Certified Career Program as may be ultimately determined by the Scholarship Board.

Testing shall be conducted by a competent authority selected by the Scholarship Board. The test shall be administered on the first Saturday of May. Applicants will be notified of the time and place of the test. Test scores will be utilized to determine the scholarship winner. A number for identification purposes will be assigned each student to ensure confidentiality and impartiality as names are not required by the testing authority.

Club Scholarship Applications are forwarded to all Berks County Schools in January of each year with the deadline for submittal being March 15th. Lodge and Ladies Scholarship applications may be picked up at the club starting January 1 of each year and must be returned by March 15th. Applications received after the deadlines are Ineligible. The Scholarship Board will screen all applications received to assess eligibility.

Applicants who find themselves unavailable or for any other reason not able to take the test at the scheduled day and time **will NOT** be allowed to test for this scholarship. **The test must be taken on the date and time assigned...NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The scholarship will be officially awarded at a special dinner conducted for that purpose in June of the scholarship year at the Club headquarters or, as may be periodically determined by the Lodge, at a similar festivity incorporating this and other Lodge events.
