# Dear Friends of Blair Wrestling,

Happy New Year to everyone! Here are some updates from our recent competitions, which have kicked off the new year on a strong note.

## Armbar Duals in Albany, NY

We traveled to Albany for four dual meets, where we wrestled a variety of competitors. January is dual season, and it was great to see so many of our kids get fired up for one another's matches and to get some new guys out on the mat and in the action as well.

### Here are the results:

Blair vs. Monroe-Woodbury: Win 65-3 Blair vs. Iona Prep: Win 60-12 Blair vs. Plainedge: Win 65-0 Blair vs. St. Francis: Win 52-12

St. Francis is always the top team in New York, and the match was highlighted by our ninth-grade heavyweight, TJ Kellas '28, beating the top heavyweight in the state in dominating fashion.

Our girls wrestled alongside the guys in an individual freestyle tournament. Corynne McNulty '27, Victoria Carbonaro '27 and Marie Sharp '28 all took first place in their weight class. Sela Rozov '27 took second.

## St. Edward's and Lake Highland Prep Duals in Orlando, FL

Next, we traveled to Orlando, Florida, to wrestle two of the top teams in the country. We had to approach both matches with a mix of technical and strategic preparation. Lake Highland brought a very experienced and senior group, and so our young guys in the middle of the lineup met some difficult challenges. I do think it was a good experience for them, as this will show them the level of fight that's needed to improve. Finishing attacks is incredibly important, and we got exposed in that match. We will definitely learn from it and come back stronger. We had a strong match with St. Edward's, with impressive wins from Ryan Meier '26 and Barry Norman '26.

### Eastern States—Girls

The girls wrestled in the Eastern States the same weekend as the Orlando Duals, and three of our girls won individual titles. Corynne, Marie and Victoria all shined again, winning three individual titles.

## Wyoming Seminary Dual

We came up short at home against Wyoming Seminary, losing 21 to 39. There were some critical, tight matches that did not go our way—at 106, 132, 165, 190 and 285—but we will learn from them and be ready when we hit them again at National Preps. "Grit" is a word we use and emphasize a lot, and given that these guys are young, we know that they will grow, develop and meet the challenge. Both the coaches and wrestlers are committed to working hard and improving with every match. A little more grit reverses these outcomes, and so I have to do a better job as a coach, and these guys need to keep working.

The girls wrestled in some individual matches. Marie Sharp pulled off an exciting victory at the buzzer to win 8-6 against a veteran opponent. It was nice to see her tough out the win at the end. Victoria Carbonaro had a tough loss in her match, but she will have an opportunity to bounce back and turn it around at National Preps.
