

OVERVIEW

The school was founded in 1888 and is the oldest continuously operating American school abroad. Located on a 14.5-acre campus, ASF enrolls on average 2,548 students in four schools: Early Childhood Center (three-year-olds, pre-kinder and kindergarten), Lower School (grades 1-5), Middle School (grades 6-8) and Upper School (grades 9-12).

ACCREDITATION AND CURRICULUM

The American School Foundation (ASF) is accredited by Cognia and the Southern Association of Independent Schools (SAIS). Through this accreditation, all students receive a valid U.S. high school diploma. Students who enroll in the Dual (American and Mexican) programs are scheduled in courses of national content and Spanish language. These courses are mandatory to obtain official documents from SEP (grades 7–12) and the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) for grades 10–12. These documents allow students to study in Mexico.













ASF offers the International Baccalaureate Primary Years (PYP) and Diploma Programmes (DP). Students may apply during the second semester of 10th grade to be enrolled in the IB Diploma Program for 11th and 12th grades. Qualified students must be approved by the Academic Dean. Approval is based on grades, NWEA scores, PSAT scores, and placement tests. Approved students are permitted to enroll in individual IB and/or AP courses, as well as work towards earning the AP International Diploma and/or AP Capstone Diploma.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR AND SCHEDULE

There are 190 school days divided into two semesters. The first semester begins the second week of August and concludes in December. The second semester begins the second week of January and concludes the second week of June. Mid-year grades are available in mid-January. Classes meet every other day for 75 minutes on a standard A-B block schedule. There are four class periods per day.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The following are the requirements for the graduating class of 2025

The successful completion of each year-long course earns one unit of credit; a semester course counts as half a unit. The American School requires **27 units** for graduation. All units must be completed between grades 9 through 12. Students must take a minimum of seven courses per semester in grades 9-11 and a minimum of 6 in grade 12.

- **4** units of English (one per year)
- 4 units of an Additional World Language (one per year) 4.0 units of Spanish for students enrolled in Mexican Program
- 4 units of Lab Science (one per year)
- Must include 1.0 unit of: Biology, Chemistry and Physics

- **3** units of Mathematics Must include: Algebra II or higher
- **1.5** units of Arts and Design
- 1 unit of Physical Education
- **0.5** unit of Coding
- **0.5** unit of Health (preferably taken in grade 9)

- **3.5** units of Humanities in English (U.S. Program only)

 Must include: World History & U.S. History
- 5 units of Humanities in Spanish
- (Mexican Program only)

 Requirements are defined with counselor
- **0.5** Survey of Mexican History (U.S. Program only)
- **0.5** Psychology in English (Mexican Program only)

GRADING SYSTEM -

Students' grades are based on a 100-point scale, with 100 being the top grade awarded and 60 being the lowest passing score. Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) courses are weighted (grade x 1.099) with the exception of Theory of Knowledge (IB) which is weighted at grade x 1.049. The additional weight is reflected in the cumulative GPA which appears on the transcript. Grades below 70% in any course will not be given additional weight. **The American School Foundation does not rank students.** GPA is calculated using only grades from credits earned at ASF; no transfer grades or online course grades are included in the ASF GPA.
