Eligibility

"I'm Still Here" are the final words that Memo was heard saying before she was placed on the ventilator. She passed on July 7, 18 days later. Not only her final words, "I'm Still Here" also represents the tens of thousands of people with epilepsy who persevere each and every day, warriors who don't give up. Students who show courage when dealing with epilepsy and seizures, a strong commitment to their education, and perseverance in eliminating the obstacles epilepsy and seizures may present are welcome to apply for Memo's I'm Still Here Epilepsy Foundation Scholarship. This program is made possible by the Epilepsy Foundation Central & South Texas. To be eligible for this scholarship, applicant must:

- Have a diagnosis of epilepsy/seizure disorder
- Provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary academic or vocational program
- Be a High School Senior or currently enrolled at a trade school, college, or university and be in good standing
- Be a legal resident of Central and South Texas
- Additional weight will be given to applicants who have a history of engagement with EFCST.

Online application includes upload sections to submit supporting documents. Supporting documents are required for completion of the application. Application will allow you to save your work and return to the form at a later date to complete.

Supporting Documents

The following supporting documents are required to submit the application. Documents are to be uploaded with the application.

- Transcript
- Physician's Statement - Must have epilepsy, be under a physician's care, and currently undergoing treatment and/or taking anticonvulsant medications.
- One Letter of Reference - Suggestions for references letters might be from a teacher, clergy, volunteer experience.
- Verification of Acceptance to School - Acceptance letter must be from a college or university.
- Additional documents you would like to share with the committee, this is optional and not required.
