Clara was decorating for the party. Godfather gave Clara a nutcracker. Fritz broke the Nutcracker. Godfather fixed it.

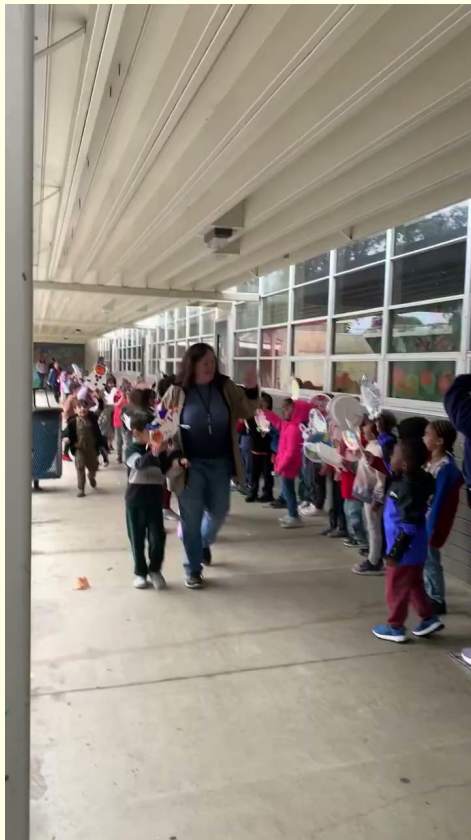
**Middle**

**End**

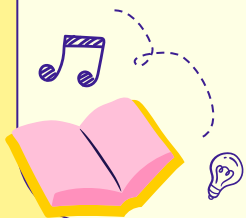
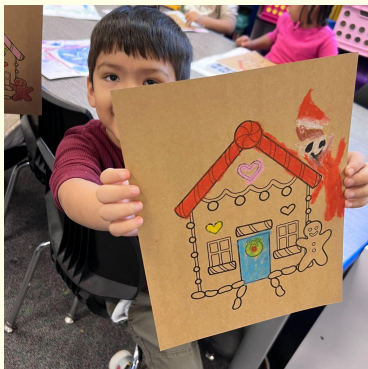

# How can you help?
