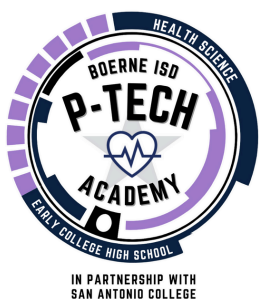


# Boerne High School Health Science P-TECH Admission Policy



We unify and educate students, parents, staff, school leadership and our greater community to strategically utilize resources and create opportunities to prepare students for in-demand, high-skill, high-wage careers. Through this program, students will explore and master skills required for high school completion in combination with earning college credits, industry certifications and work-based experience.



## Program Overview

The purpose of the Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) program is to provide a smooth transitional experience for students from high school to postsecondary education and employment. Our regional workforce shows a growing demand, high wage occupations in the field of health science.

The P-TECH program shall:

- Earn a high school diploma
- Provide open enrollment and no cost to students
- Provide an opportunity to earn postsecondary credential and/or industry-based certification alignment to regional workforce needs
- have the opportunity to earn an associate degree
- Provide work-based learning at every grade level

## Admission

All applicants will be considered, and have an equal opportunity for acceptance, regardless of background or academic performance. Should all the seats become filled, Boerne HS P-TECH shall use either a performance-blind, open-access lottery system that encourages and considers applications from all students (all students have an equal opportunity for acceptance, regardless of background or academic performance).
