DISCIPLINARY POINT SYSTEM- AGE OF STUDENT ELIGIBILITY.


Disciplinary point system - Age of student eligibility. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each student over the age of 12 years who is enrolled in a public or private secondary school shall be subject to a disciplinary point system for an infraction committed on school property to determine the age at which the student shall be allowed to apply for a learner's permit, motor driven cycle operator's license, driver's license, or any license required by the State of Alabama for the operation of a motor vehicle or vessel. The disciplinary points imposed for a disciplinary action shall be as follows:

- (1) One day in-school suspension 1 point.
- (2) One day out-of-school suspension 2 points.
- (3) Alternative school placement 6 points.
- (4) Expulsion 20 points.
- (b)(1) The points shall accumulate on a yearly basis, beginning with the school year including summer school in which the student turns 13, and accumulate each year until the student is eligible to apply for a driver's license under the imposed point system.
- (2) Notwithstanding subdivision (1), the age at which a student may apply for a license or permit shall not be extended by Act 2009-713 beyond one year from the date the student initially applies for a learner's permit, motor driven cycle operator's license, driver's license, or any license required by the State of Alabama for the operation of a motor vehicle or vessel.






EACH ACCUMULATED POINT SHALL ADD ONE ADDITIONAL WEEK TO THE AGE AT WHICH THE STUDENT IS ELIGIBLE TO BE ISSUED A LEARNER'S PERMIT, MOTOR DRIVEN CYCLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE, OR DRIVER'S LICENSE.



- (c) The following subdivisions are contingent upon the technical capability of the student data management system to track, manage, and coordinate the data:
- (1) Points shall be accrued on a school-year basis.
- (2) Points may not accrue for the first three days of in-school suspension in any school year; however, beginning with the fourth day of suspension in any school year, all days, including the first three, of in-school suspension shall be counted in determining the points.
- (3) Points may not accrue for an initial out-of-school suspension of two days or less in any school year; however, the days of the initial suspension shall be used to determine the points after a second out-of-school suspension in any school year or all days will be used to determine points if the initial suspension exceeds two days.
- (4) Accumulated points shall be reduced by one-half if the student has not received additional accumulated points for one school year. If no additional points are received for two years, all records of the accumulated points shall be removed from the student's records at the school. (Act 2009-713, p. 2095, §1.)

 - 50% of students 9-week grade

Dress Code

- Skirts/Dresses/Shorts must touch the length of the longest finger with hands to the side of the body in a natural posture position.
- Pants/Jeans/etc. must fit properly and be worn at the natural waistline and may not be longer than mid-shoe level.
- Any slits/holes/leg openings may not be above the length of the longest finger with hands to the side of the body in a natural posture position.
- Leggings/yoga pants/similar garments must be worn with an appropriate length outer garment as defined above.
- Sweatpants and joggers are allowed if they are properly fitted.
- Shirts/Tops must not show the midriff with hands at 180 degrees above head. Revealing garments may not be worn at any time.
- Sleepwear/pajamas, house shoes, blankets, or pillows are not allowed.
- No visible piercings other than to the ears or nose are acceptable. Piercing to the nose may only consist of a nose stud.
- Students must wear proper undergarments.

- Students are permitted 8 parent excuses per school year. Note that this is less than last year.
- Any absences after the 8 allowed parent excuses will require a medical or legal excuse or they will be recorded as unexcused.
- Absences for official school events/field trips are considered excused.
- A written/emailed request to excuse an absence must be presented within three (3) days of the absence. Failure to present a written explanation within three days will cause the absence to be unexcused.
 - Excuses may be sent to mhsattendance@sccboe. org
 or placed in the excuse tray at the front desk.

Exam Exemption Policy

- All students will take 1st and 3rd 9 weeks exams.
- Exemptions are only allowed for 2nd and 4th 9 weeks exams.
- Absences are accumulated by class period.
- Exemptions are earned based on class average and number of absences for the semester as follows:
 - ANY unexcused absence or suspension will forfeit the exam exemption for that class.
 - 90 or above average AND no more than 4 absences
 - 80 or above average AND no more than 2 absences
 - 70 or above average AND no absences
- 3 tardies to class and/or school equals 1 unexcused absence.

Cell Phone Policy

- Absolutely No cell phones out inside of the school building from 7:15 am to 3:00 pm.
 - Cell phones are hurting the classroom learning environment.
- No ear buds, Beats, or headphones allowed in the building.
- Students can use cell phones and headphones during their lunch time.
 - This does not include inside of the building on the way to lunch.
- If a cellphone is taken up by staff, the cell phone must be picked up by a guardian AFTER SCHOOL HOURS.
 - Cannot be picked up between 8 am and 3 pm.
- Discipline for cell phone (as defined in the SCCBOE Student Code of Conduct)
 - Step 1: Warning
 - Step 2: Saturday School
 - Step 3: ISS/ or 2 days Saturday School Step
 - 4: 1 Day Out of School Suspension
 - Step 5: Referral to RYAS (20 days)



Attendance Procedures

- For an absence to be "excused", parents/guardians must present to the school principal or designee a written explanation of a student's absence within three (3) days of the absence.
 - Each student only has 8 parent excuses per year.
- Failure to present a written explanation will cause the absence to be recorded as unexcused.
- **NEW CHANGE:** If an excuse is not turned in within the three days of returning to school, a parent excuse will be used to code the absence until the **limit of 8 parent excuses** have been used.
- Any excuse after that point will require a medical or legal excuse.
- Absences for official school events are considered "school excused".
- Students can bring the physical excuse to the main office OR it can be emailed to <u>mhsattendance@sccboe.org</u>.
- ALL REQUESTS TO CHECK IN OR CHECK OUT MUST BE EMAILED TO MHSATTENDANCE@SCCBOE.ORG.
 - Students cannot check out via phone call.
 - The email does not serve as a "parent excuse", and a student must return a parent excuse when he or she returns for us to use a parent excuse.
 - Students can bring a check-out notice, but it must be turned in prior to their first class.
- Any student in grades 9-12 who accumulates excessive unexcused absences in any course may not receive credit in that course.
 - A student may not exceed eighteen (18) absences per class per year.



- The app is FREE to download and use through the App store (iPhone) and Google play (Androids).





Lunch
