All Davies High School students have the opportunity to explore a wide variety of potential career paths that interest them at the school's Career Day on Tuesday. Students in grades 9-12 will get an up-close and personal look at their choice of a broad array of careers and speak with representatives from 76 organizations.

Each student has signed up for three 25-minute breakout sessions to learn more about a specific potential career. They were given the options to choose from a large list of careers including sales, broadcasting, entrepreneurship, plumbing, music industry, sports marketing, meteorology, engineering, law, medicine, welding, dentistry, construction, and more.

Representatives from local, regional, and national companies have volunteered their time and expertise to visit with students. They will share information about how and why they decided to pursue their current job; training required for the job; types of jobs within their field; what to expect during a typical day at the job; job market and availability; and work hours, setting, conditions, and challenges associated with the job. They are encouraged to provide hands-on and interactive activities for students to participate in.
