Communications

Community Involvement

We're fortunate to have an active Association of Parents and Teachers (APT) and an engaged School Improvement Council, along with Title I committees. Our APT hosts an annual fall fundraiser to assist with materials and equipment for our school. Additionally, we have faith-based mentors who volunteer to work with our students after school. We take part in a variety of community service projects, including Food Drives, Jump Rope for Heart, and Pennies for Pasta.

SAFETY

The safety of our students is a top priority. The doors to our school remain locked at all times. We operate an automated check-in system for visitors and utilize a call-back system in every classroom. In addition to interior and exterior cameras across our campus, we have a School Safety Team and two, full-time nurses.
