

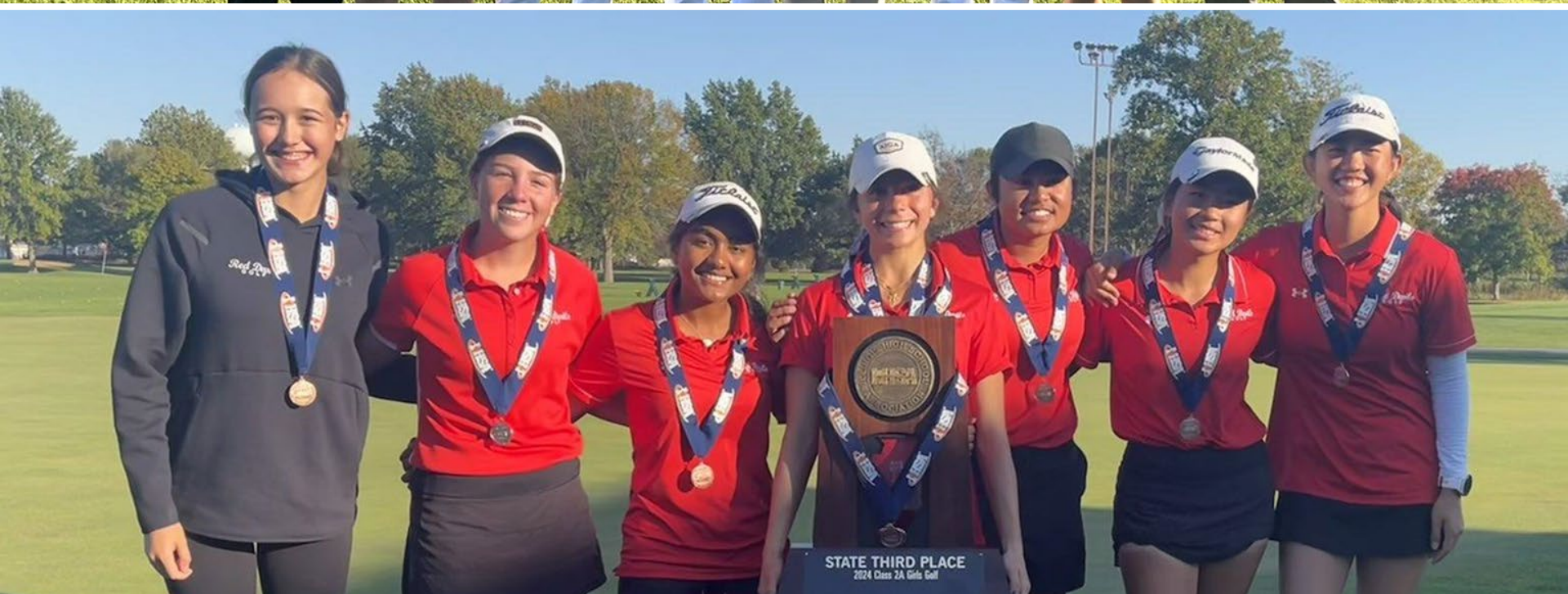
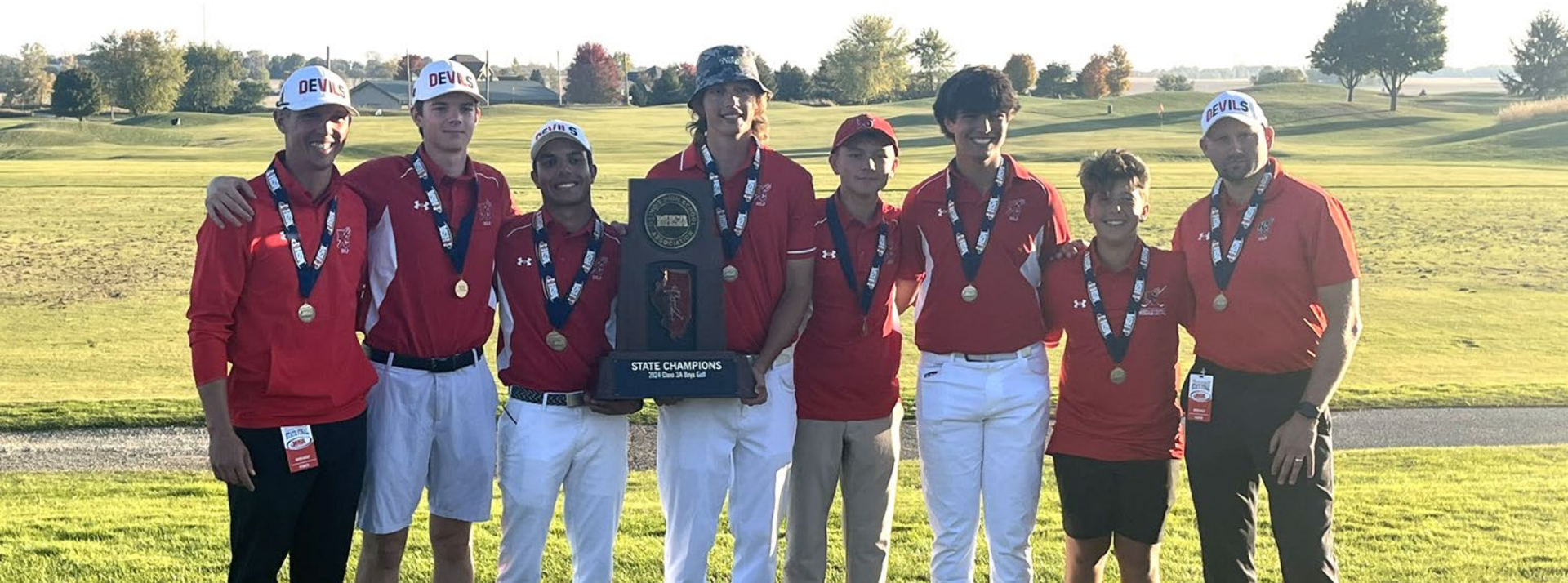

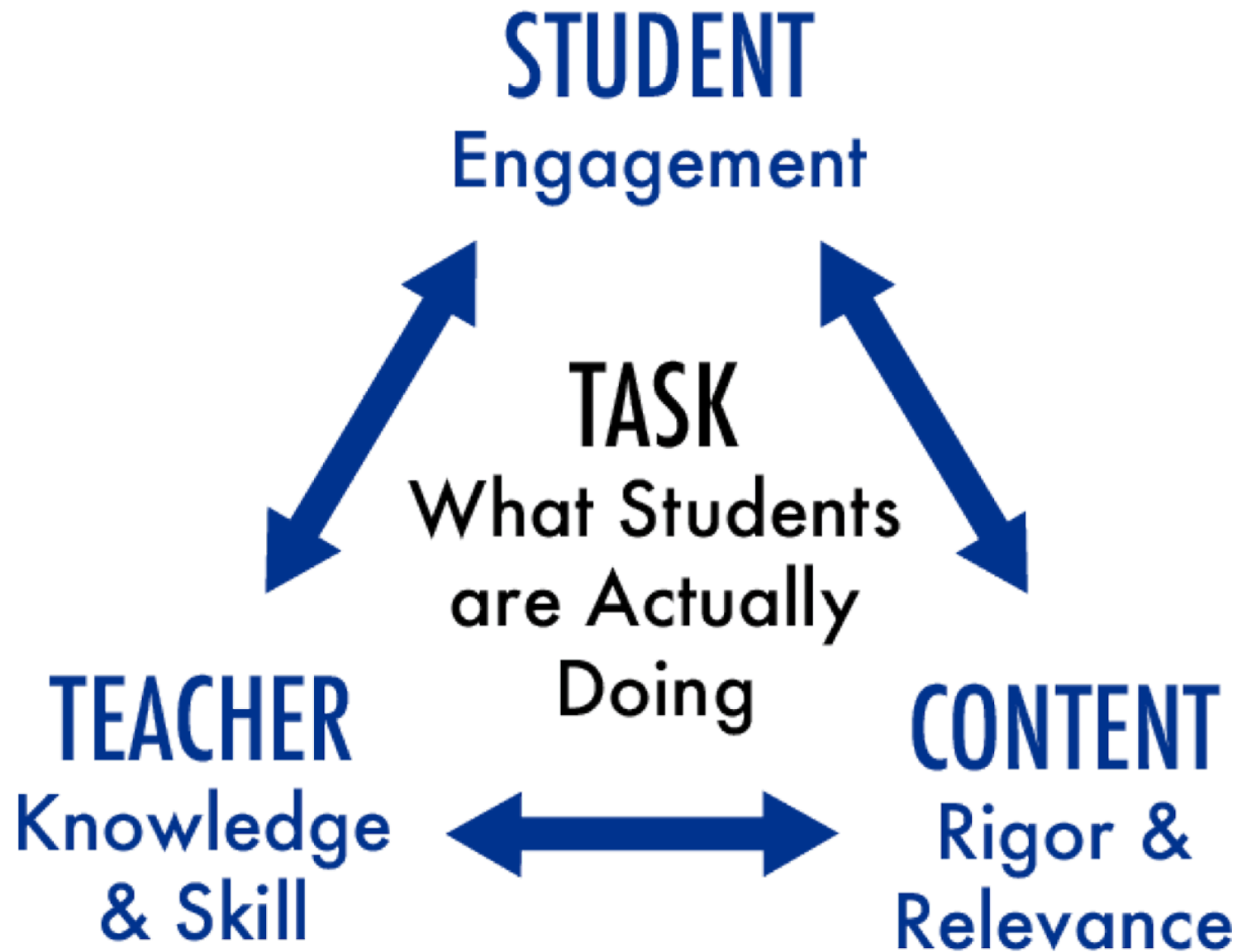

Enrollment for Rising Ninth Grade Families

Every year, the middle schools that feed into District 86 provide us with contact information for the families of eighth grade students who are eligible to attend high school at Hinsdale South or Hinsdale Central. | Academic Resource Center (ARC) | The ARC is available for all students. Students can get help from student tutors in every subject and from HCHS math teachers. Students can stop in for homework help, review for an assessment, make corrections, brainstorm outlines for essays, proofread papers, and more. During lunch, no appointment is necessary, just stop in. If students are visiting during a study hall and/or resource period, they will need a pass from their classroom teacher to leave the study hall and attend the ARC.
