Middle School Leveling

Grade Level

- Students who can learn at a continuous pace
- Courses provide essential skills & content knowledge aligned to grade level standards
- Collaborative & guided learning through a variety of instructional activities and assessments

Honors

- Students who can learn enriched content at a challenging pace
- Rigorous grade level curriculum
- Collaborative, guided, & self-directed learning through a variety of instructional activities and assessments

Accelerated Honors

- Students who can learn advanced content at an accelerated pace
- Rigorous
 curriculum that
 extends beyond
 grade level
- Collaborative & self-directed learning through a variety of instructional activities and assessments



Placement Decisions

- Placement of students into appropriate courses is an important factor that contributes to student success.
- Multiple data points: PSSA, student performance in class, and teacher recommendations.
- Additional assessment data may be considered should any be available for individual students.
- Questions about recommended course levels, should be directed to your child's teacher



Rising 7th Grade Selections



Reading <u>or</u> World Language

7th grade is the students' last official year to take reading and build upon comprehension skills and practice reading strategies.

If recommended for Reading:

You will see a Reading class listed as part of the schedule when you view recommendations (<u>do not</u> select a World Language or Reading course)

If **NOT** recommended for Reading:

Select either French 1, German 1, Italian 1, Latin 1, Spanish 1, or Reading Through Time 7 (also select an alternate World Language or Reading Honors); high level course; 20–30 minutes of homework each day

Select a Music Elective

All rising 7th Grade students must select a music class: Music Production & Technology 7 <u>OR</u> a Performing Music-Chorus 7*, Band 7*, or Orchestra 7*

 Note: Students in Chorus 7, Band 7, and Orchestra 7 will perform individually, in small groups, and in an ensemble. Participation in winter and spring concerts is mandatory



Rising 8th Grade Selections



Reading <u>or</u> World Language

If recommended for Reading:

You will see a Reading class listed as part of the schedule when you view recommendations (<u>do not</u> select a World Language or Reading course)

If NOT recommended for Reading:

- Select either French 1, German 1, Italian 1, Latin 1 or Spanish 1, (also select an alternate World Language) or Reading & Writing for Life
- Level 2 languages will be recommended based on successful completion of level 1 courses.

- View teacher recommendations from content area classes
- If not recommended for Reading, select a World Language or Reading Through Time 7 Honors
- Select a music:
 - Chorus 7, Band 7,
 Orchestra 7 or Classroom
 Music 7

Rising 8th Grade Students/Parents

- View teacher recommendations from content area classes
- If not recommended for Reading, select a World Language or Reading & Writing for Life
- Select a music (Chorus 8, Band 8, Orchestra 8)
 OR "No Music Option"
- Select 4 Unified Arts classes (and two alternates)

Special Education Students & the Course Selection Process

- IEP needs of each student determine their courses.
- Special Education students should still request their preferred Unified Arts Electives.


