- **Volunteer Coordinator** - This is an open, 1yr commitment position. The incumbent Ruth Guest intends to run.
- **School Community Enrichment Coordinator** - This is an open, 1yr commitment position. The incumbent Lindsay Smith intends to run.


# School Community Enrichment Update
