



- → Powerschool logins and HCS logins are the same. Parents make sure you can access Powerschool





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

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

School Procedures



- → Students will exit through the front doors to attend CCU classes and must scan out as they leave during the school day.
- In the afternoon, car riders should exit by the back door.
 - No one should open any doors to allow people in. ALL access must be through the front doors.



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- → Clear bags required <u>see HCS guidelines here</u>
- → Procedure:
 - ◆ Walk through with your book bag strapped on your front
 - Pass your laptop to the adult on duty
 - Phones, airpods & keys may remain in pockets
 - Umbrellas, certain glasses cases, binders will make the system alert
 - If the system alerts on you, you will be required to move to a secondary search area
 - lack If the system does not alert on you, you can keep it moving















- → Students without bags will be able to pass through this screening more quickly.
- → Students with athletic bags/equipment will "check them" with the security guard and then pick them up when they leave. Students will not have access to these bags during the school day.
 - → Students should use their lockers and/or leave books at home unless instructed to bring them for a specific day.


































Scholars Academy Schoology



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Schoology as our instructional platform. This platform provides fingertip, remote, and constant access to assignments and assessments. Assignments will be submitted using Schoology.




Information with be shared during the first week of classes with students and how parents can monitor progress.










Scholars Station Schedule: (55 Minutes on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday) (75 minutes on Tuesday, and Thursday)

- Electronic devices may NOT be used to access social media, TV shows, games, or other non-academic sites



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

 - earn a minimum 4.00 cumulative GPA on the SC UGP at the end of the junior year



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


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





Honor Societies


