Kevin McFadden Trades Scholarship Fund

This Scholarship Fund was created to honor our son, Kevin McFadden, who died on August 1, 2018 in a motorcycle accident. Kevin was 21 when he passed.

Kevin was passionate about welding, fabrication and heavy diesel equipment mechanics. He took 4 years of manufacturing and fabrication in high school and belonged to the Skills USA Club. After high school, he made his career in heavy diesel mechanics and fabrication.

Kevin always strived for perfection in his work and was always willing to help others.

His hobbies included road bikes, dirt bikes and 4-wheel drive trucks.

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for trade school classes such as welding, fabrication, mechanics, carpentry, etc. Scholarships will be paid \$500 the first semester and \$500 the second semester.

Qualifications

Scholarships will be awarded to students graduating from high school and attending a trade school or college.

The students awarded this scholarship will have to show the same passion and dedication for the trade they have chosen as Kevin did.

The student must have taken classes in a CTE program such as welding, fabrication, mechanics, woodworking, carpentry, etc...

The student must have one or more references from a CTE instructor.

The student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
