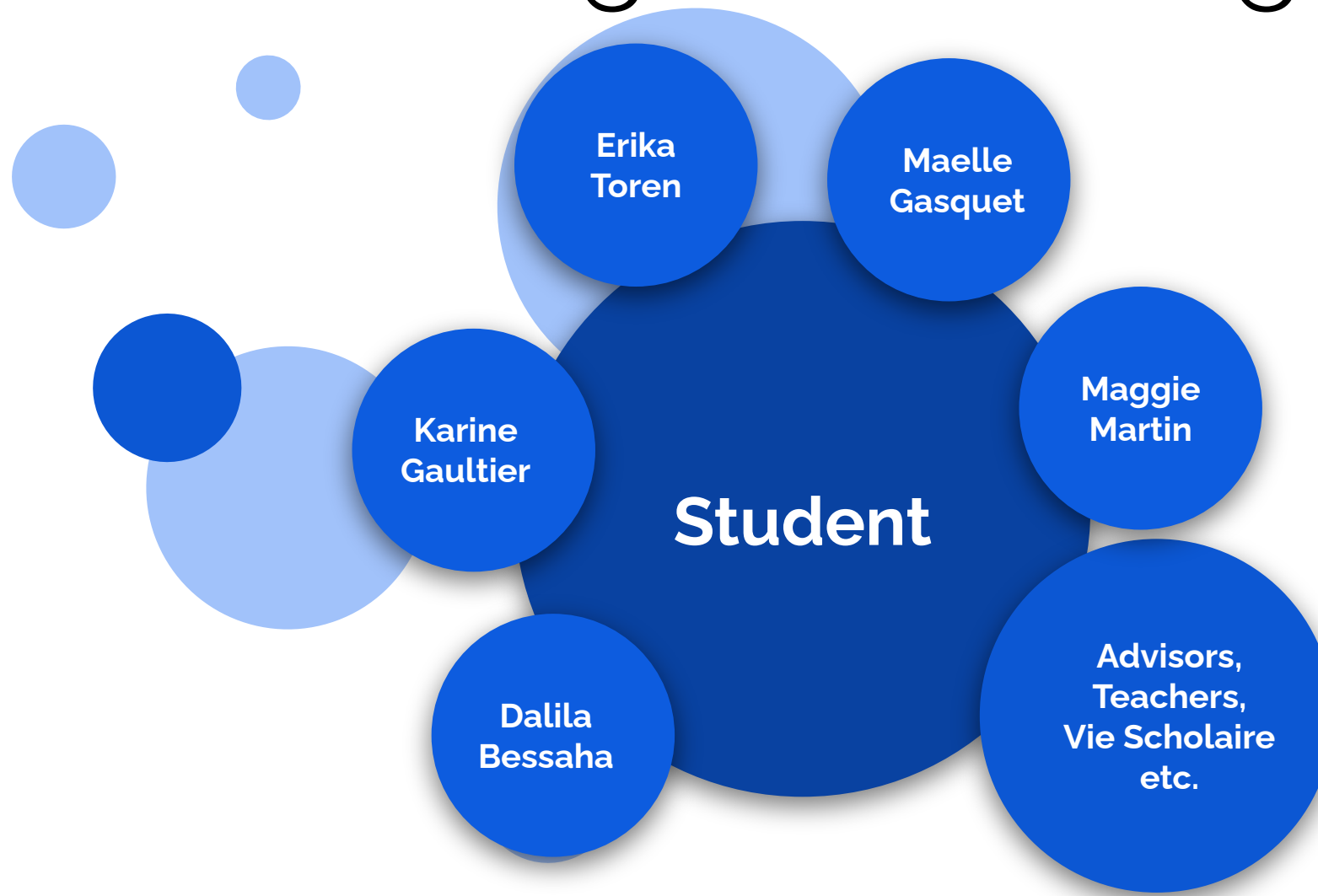

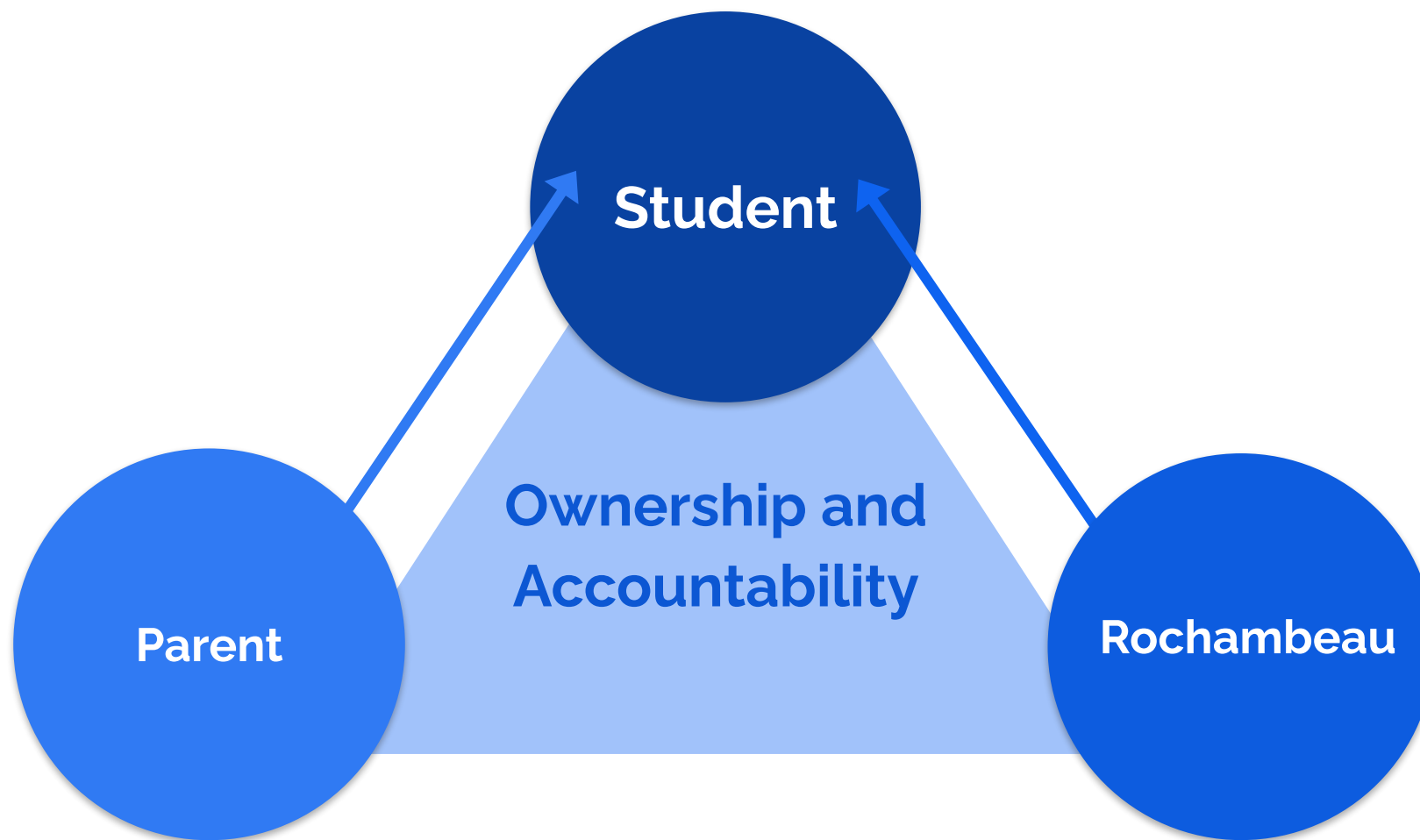

Leadership, resilience, and a compelling personal story.

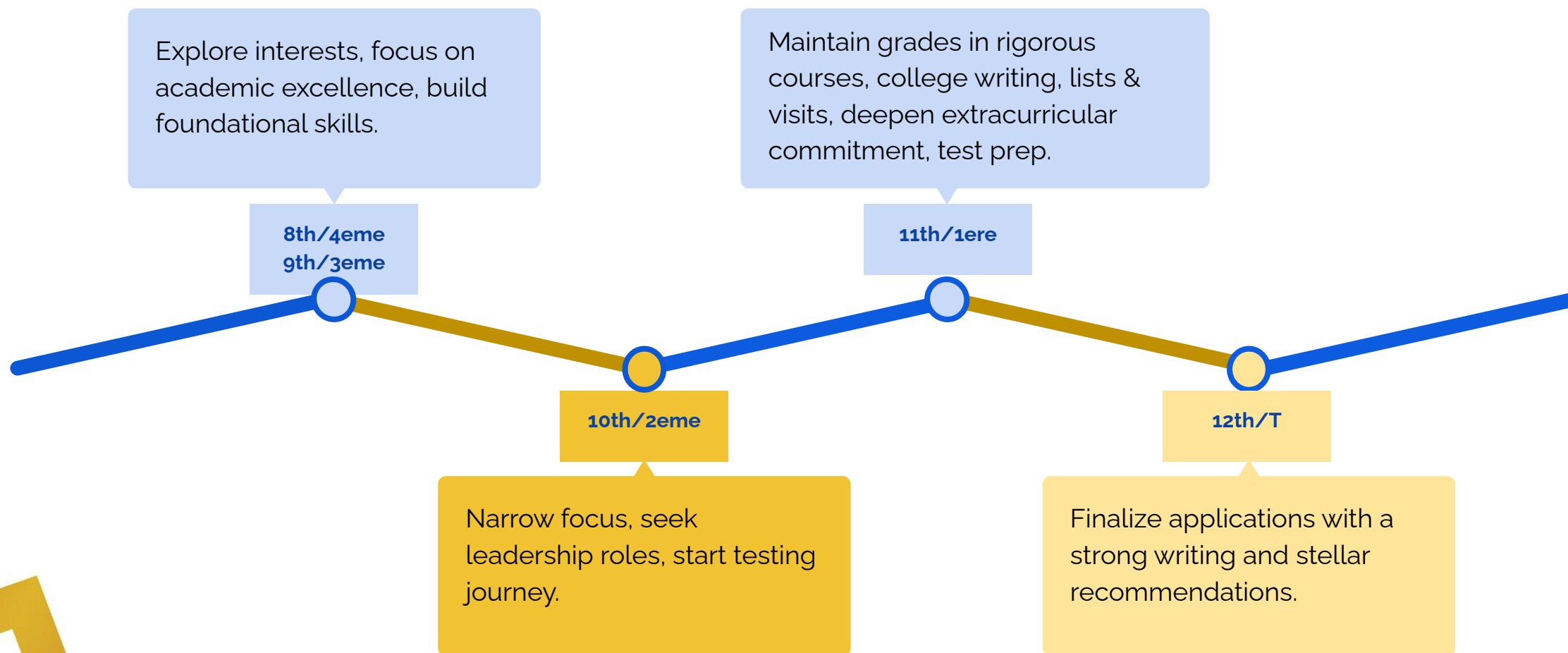


Laying the Foundation: 4eme & 3eme

Academic Excellence	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Course Selection: Prepare for rigorous courses in high school.● Reading Habit: Encourage diverse and challenging reading.● Study Skills: Build strong study habits and time management now.
Extracurricular Exploration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Find Their Passion: Encourage your child to explore various interests (sports, arts, STEM, debate).● Leadership Opportunities: Promote activities where they can take initiative.● Consistency Over Time: Depth matters more than breadth.
Personal Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Build Character: Foster curiosity, resilience, and empathy.● Community Service: Encourage giving back through meaningful projects.● Develop a Unique Story: Help them connect activities to personal growth and goals.

Limiting the search.

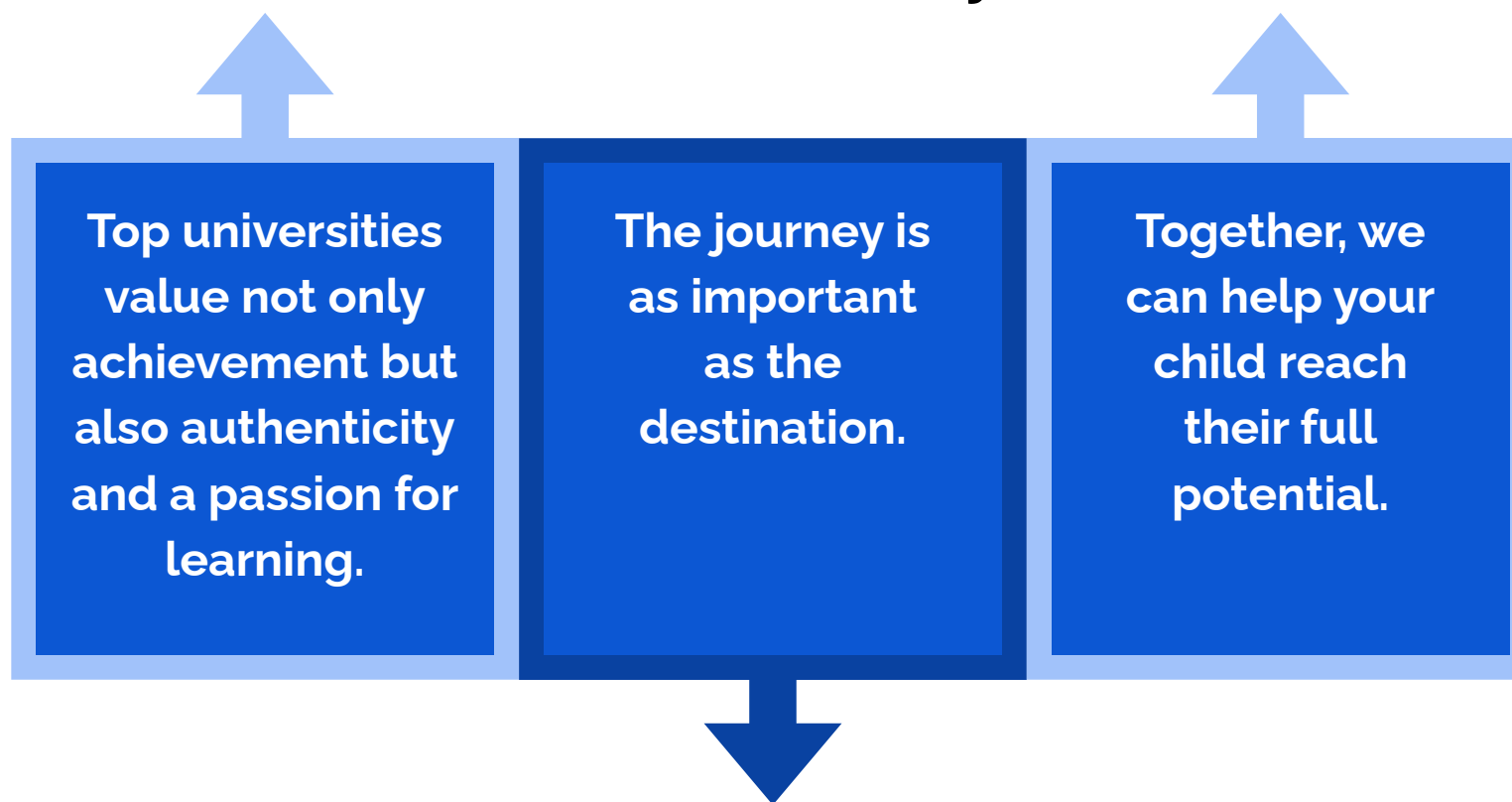
