Brent Strohmeyer Memorial Foundation Scholarship

Brent Strohmeyer (son of Russ and Margie Strphmeyer) of Stayton, OR, dies at the age of 20 years as a passenger in an auto accident in 2001. He was very active in the automotive hobby and loved attending car shows and cruise-ins in his Hugger Orange '69' Chevelle.

Brent enjoyed working on cars and continually strove to learn more and improve his automotive skills. He was a gifted artist and liked drawing cars and trucks. His work was featured on car show t-shirts and posters.

Brent believed that classic cars were to be restored, maintained and driven. Not to be neglected, crushed or left to rust away in a field.

Funds for three or more scholarships ranging from \$400-\$2,000 were raised for the Brent Strohmeyer Memorial Foundation through sponsorship, t-shirt sales and raffles for the 2024 Brent Strohmeyer Memorial Car Show amd generous donations from others. There were 310 registered cars and trucks to pay tribute to Brent.

With the help of our sponsors and the people who love cars, we have been able to give 99 scholarships since 2003. We hope to continue this tradition of honoring Brent's life, promoting the automotive hobby, and offering scholarships to students to help them continue in their quest of fulfilling an education.

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Eligibility:

Any graduating student or college student who is a resident in Linn, Marion, or Polk counties or had their senior portraits taken at Stro's Photography with a minimum GPA of 2.5. Applicant must prove an interest in the automotive hobby <u>or</u> enroll in automotive classes in an institution or higher education (includes community colleges and trade schools).

Selection:

Three recipients and an alternate will be chosen based on financial need and their automotive interest. Selection committee's decision will be final.

Amount:

Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$400 to any accredited two or four year institution, to be issued as a one-time payment to the school, at the beginning of the of the student's second term or semester. If any recipient abandons his or her education, is not a full time student or fails to maintain satisfactory academic progress, the amount of the scholarship funds remaining shall be paid to an alternate or revert to the scholarship fund.

Portrait:

We will need a 5x7 of each winner (we will take this portrait for you). Each recipient's portrait will be on our scholarship display board.

Applications will be accepted between January 15 and April 15 of each year.
