Eligibility:

- Completion of application
- Recipients will be strongly encouraged to attend a fundraising auction in Lebanon April 12, 2025 at Santiam Place and asked to introduce themselves and briefly speak about the impact of this community-funded scholarship.

- No GPA *minimum* requirements, we are seeking students who demonstrate the desire to pursue higher education.

- Students who have demonstrated leadership skills.
