- 1. Call to Order-7:05pm
 - a. 5 board members, 4 parent attendees, Mr. DuFresne, Mr. Burden
- 2. Additions/Deletions to Agenda-None
- 3. Motion to approve the meeting-Nancy Davis, Second to approve Mr. DuFresne
- 4. Reports
 - a. Principal Mr. Vernon Burden
 - i. Dr. Machesky apologizes he could not make it.
 - ii. Conclusion of 1st term-system updates. Hall pass system, getting great data and feedback. Draw some correlations with time out of class and grades. Reduction in referrals and hallway issues. Over 80% of disciplinary issues can be tied into tardiness.
 - iii. First student holiday on Halloween & November 1st. The staff had two days of professionals dedicating themselves to improving themselves. The first day was around leading differentiating instruction and how learners achieve knowledge and success. The second was training outside of curriculum i.e. Bloodborne pathogens. They also had the opportunity to choose sessions that they wanted to attend, the biggest session was on AI and how it can be used to improve instruction.
 - iv. Transition to Winter Sports from Fall Sports
 - 1. Many of our teams did great in the fall including Girls Golf, Girls Volleyball and Cross Country teams. They had championships and state qualifiers.
 - v. Five student athletes signed to collegiate sports. Amazing opportunities for these students. Congratulations to those students. 2 from Softball, 1 from Soccer and 2 from LaCrosse.
 - vi. National Merit Finalists-9 individual finalists. 69 individuals from Troy Schools. 13% from the state of Michigan are from Troy Schools. The community has done well in supporting and growing these students.
 - vii. Athens Family University was held October 30th. Great first start to the program.
 - 1. Next One will be in January-Date to Be Determined. Anatomy of how grades are constructed, made, how to improve them.
 - viii. Safety & Security Updates-Security will be piloting the visitor management system of the hall pass system. Visitors will have to glve identification to the shield desk and it will print the badge with your picture and where you are supposed to be going.

 - ii. Bond Updates-Series 1 has taken place
 - 1. Smith Middle School-Work Started in May 24, opening 2026/2027 school year
 - 2. Athens groundbreaking will start in 2027
 - 3. Synthetic turf and new tennis courts-Athens. Spectator viewing on the tennis courts. Baseball field, Softball field and additional practice field for football, will start after the spring sports and be done for next spring. A new track will go into place also for next year.
