

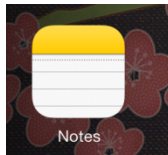
Backing up data on the iPad

Before we restore your iPad, data/information/pictures you want to save needs to be backed up

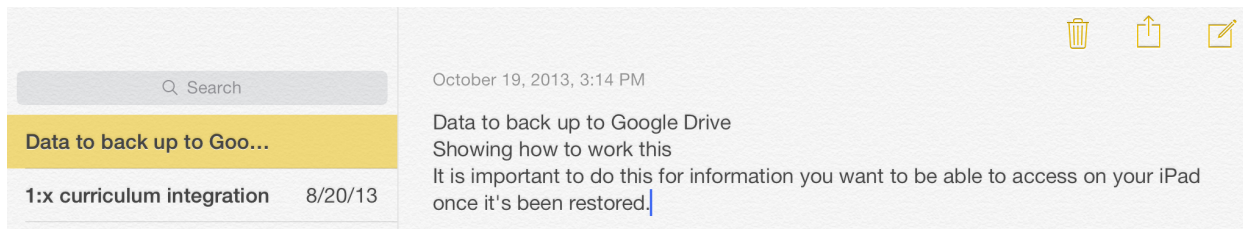
There are a few apps whose information backs up to online clouds. Evernote does that. So does Google Drive. **Notes and camera roll do not.**

The best way is Google Drive.

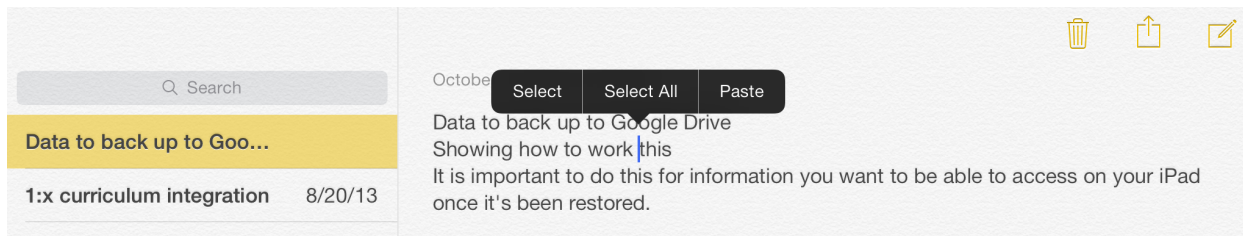
To back up your notes to Google Drive, open Notes.



Open the note you wish to back up

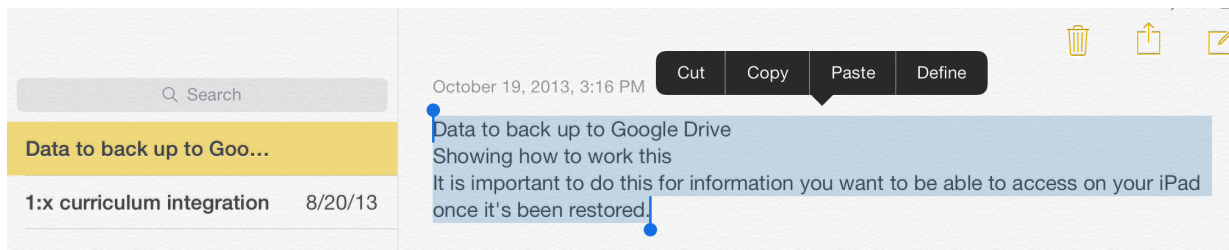


Push and hold anywhere in the notes until the copy/paste feature appears.

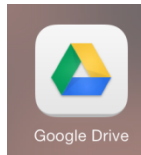


Click Select All

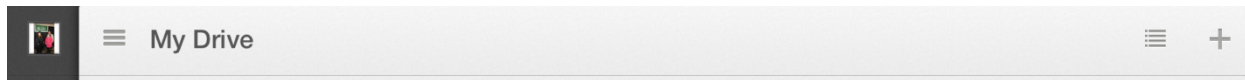
Click Copy



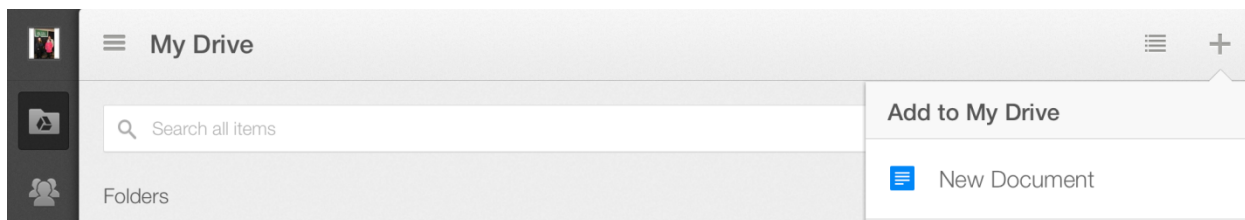
Open the Google Drive app



Click the + for creating a new file (in the top right corner)

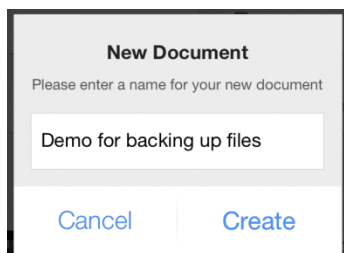


Click New Document



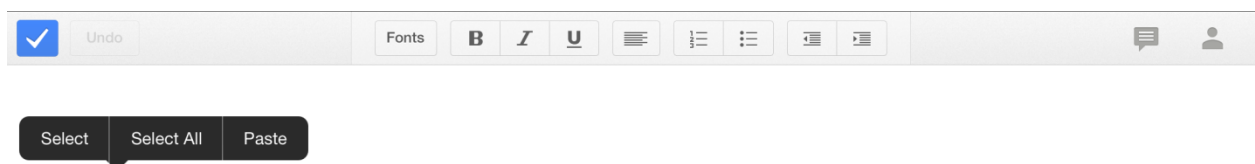
Name your document

Click create



Push and hold in the blank part of the new document until the copy/paste feature appears

Click paste



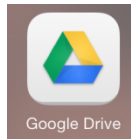
Your information appears in a Google Drive file and can be accessed from any device that connects to the Internet



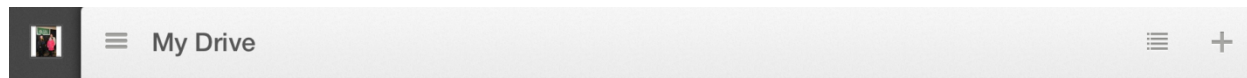
Click the blue check mark

To back up pictures/videos to Google Drive

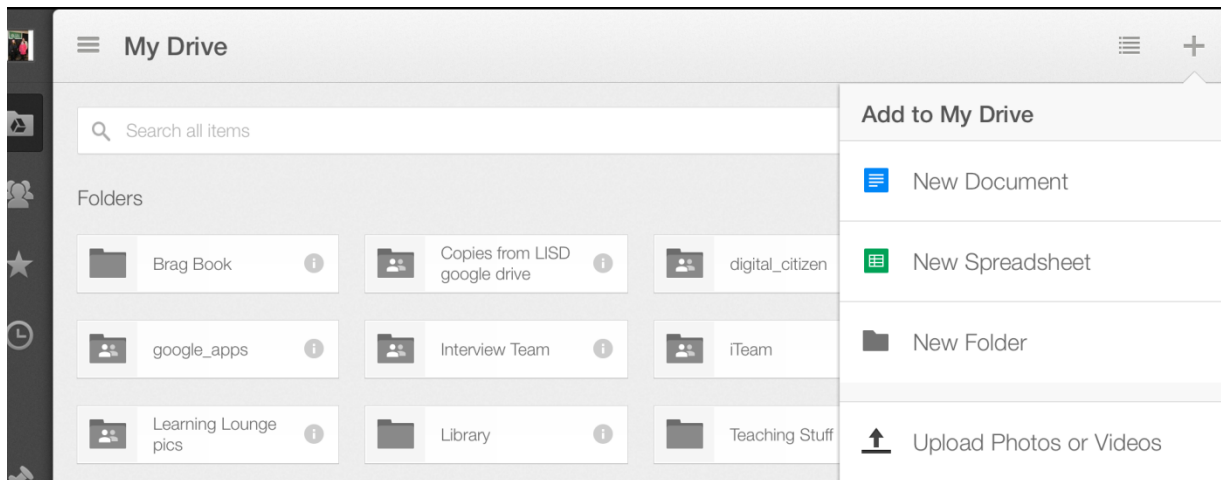
Open the Google Drive app



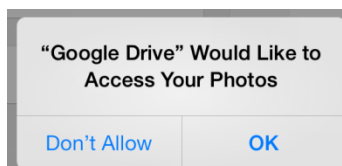
Click the plus sign in the top right corner



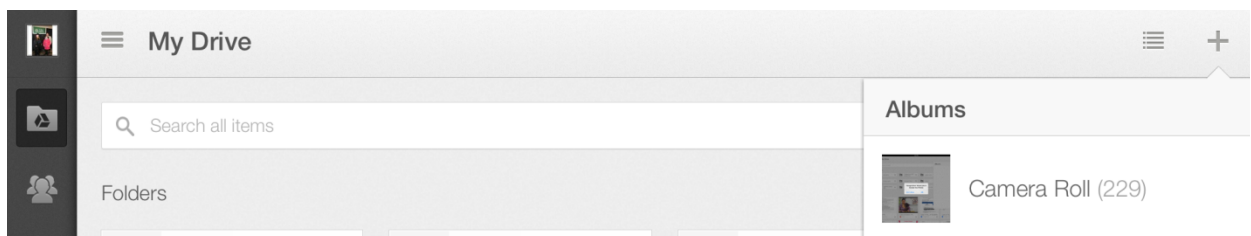
Click upload photos or video



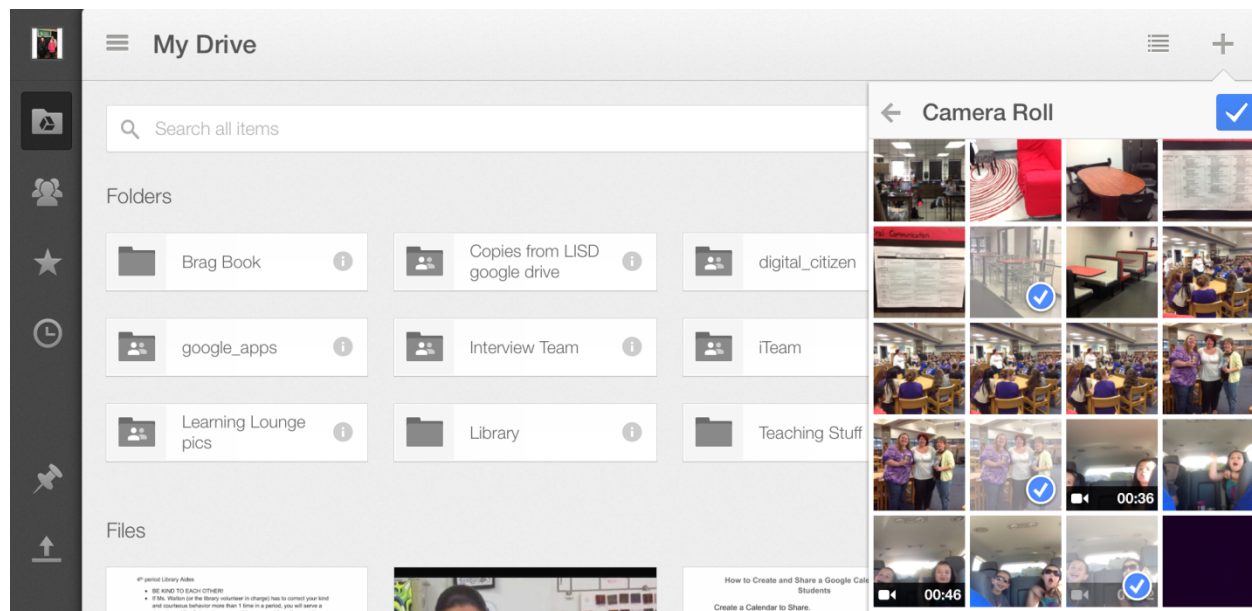
If you get the question "Google Drive" would like to access your photos, click OK



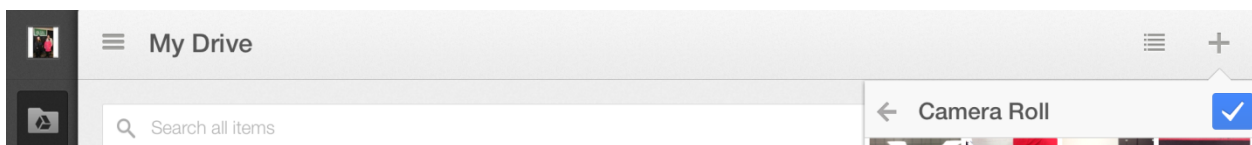
Click Camera Roll
