Founded in 1965, Moreau Catholic is an independent, Catholic college preparatory institution sponsored by the Congregation of Holy Cross and fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges for the maximum term possible. 810 students are currently enrolled in grades 9 through 12. **The Class of 2025 totals 165 students.** The ethnic composition of the student body is: 12.2% African- American; 39.7% Asian/Filipino; 7.2% European-American; 23.2% Hispanic/Latino; 3% Pacific Islander/ Hawaiian; 12.7% multiracial/ other; 1.7% declined to state. A total of 204 students graduated in 2024. Moreau Catholic is located in Hayward, a suburban Bay Area community with a population of 160,050 and serves Southern Alameda County. It is the sixth largest city in the San Francisco Bay Area. Students commute to Moreau Catholic High School from as far as Livermore (East), San Jose (South), Oakland, and Hercules (North).

All students who are enrolled in Advanced Placement classes are required to take the AP exam for the class or classes in which they are enrolled. In May 2025, 236 students plan to take 536 examinations.

Moreau Catholic is an environment that celebrates individual achievement, where students find their voice while developing their ability to appreciate and understand the perspectives of others.

Concurrent Enrollment Policy - MCHS students take a rigorous 7-class schedule each semester, therefore, students only take concurrent enrollment courses in the summer, up to one class for rising Juniors and up to two classes for rising Seniors.
