- FAMILY AND FRIENDS CANNOT DELIVER FOOD FOR YOU

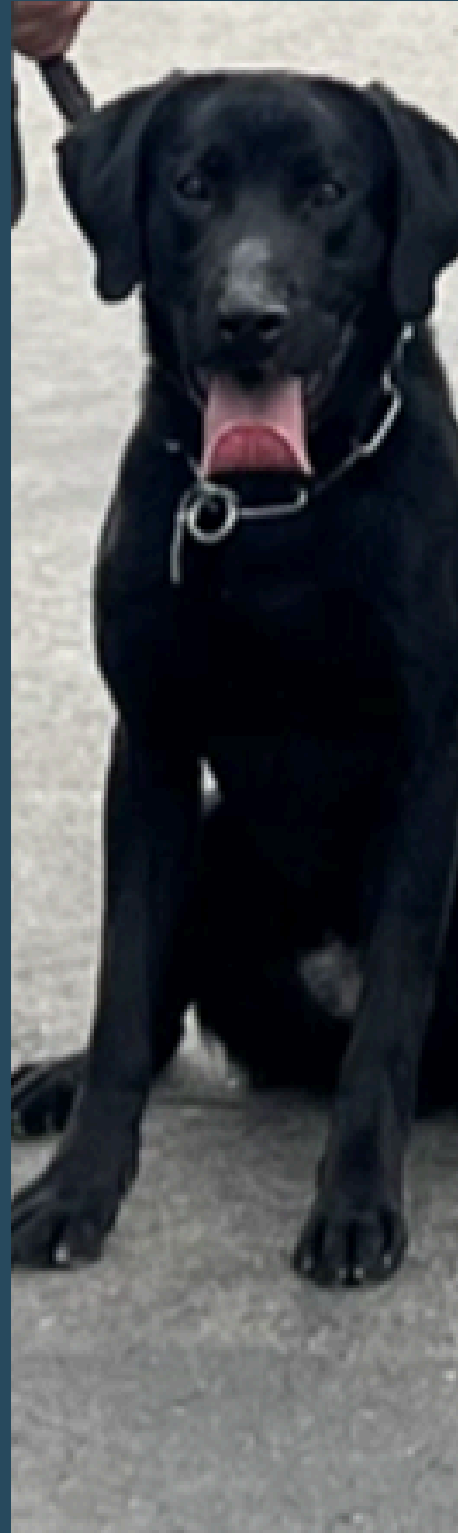








TARDIES/TARDY SWEEP
