  MORE THAN 10% OF THE SCHOOL YEAR WITH
  UNEXCUSED ABSENCES. MANY SENIORS
  ATTENDED SATURDAY SCHOOL IN
  DECEMBER AND WERE ABLE TO RECOVER A
  FULL DAY OF UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FOR
  EACH SATURDAY SESSION. SENIORS AND
  PARENTS OF SENIORS NEED TO KNOW HOW
  IMPORTANT SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS.
- FIRST PERIOD BEING ON TIME IS CRUCIAL
- STARTING UP IN JANUARY, STUDENTS WHO ARRIVE AT THE ENTRANCE OR TO THEIR CLASS AFTER OFFICIAL START TIME WILL BE ISSUED TARDIES AND AN IMMEDIATE 10 MINUTE LUNCH DETENTION. CONSEQUENCES FOR MULTIPLE DAYS OF TARDIES IN A WEEK WILL RESULT IN MANDATORY SATURDAY SCHOOL SESSIONS.
