



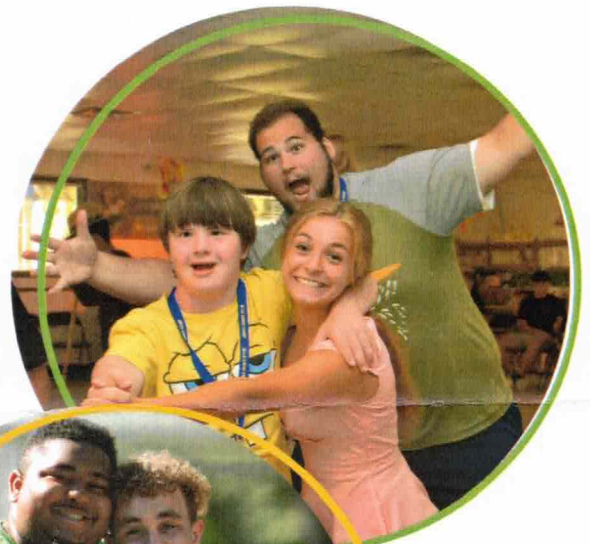

Dear Counselor:

The Louisiana Lions Camp is currently recruiting High School students, ages 16 and above, to fill summer staff positions. There are Junior Counselor positions available for 16 and 17 year-old students. Students aged 18 and above may apply for Senior Counselor and Activity Instructor positions, and those with current certifications may apply for Lifeguard positions. We will train a class for lifeguards during orientation week.

The summer staff consists of approximately sixty-five high school and college students of which at least half have previous experience in our camping program. Summer camp runs for six to seven weeks, new staff report on June 5, 2024. Staff contracts are for the full summer term of seven weeks. The first week is training and orientation for the summer staff and attendance during this week is required.

Sixty Five (+ or -) campers are assigned each week and are divided into age groups. These groups spend the week with two Senior and two Junior Counselors. The first two weeks following orientation are for 8 to 19 y/o Mentally Challenged youth, followed by two weeks for 7 to 19 y/o Physically Challenged Youth, and one week for 6 to 14 y/o Youth with Diabetes.
