2025 PBS KIDS WRITERS CONTEST!

This marks the 26th year we have participated in the PBS Kids Writers Contest. The rules are similar to previous years — kindergarten through fifth grade may write stories for the contest.

Story Requirements:

Word requirements

Kindergarten and First Grade—Minimum 50 words

Second and Third Grade—Minimum 100 words

Fourth and Fifth Grade—Minimum 150 words

Story may be fact, fiction, prose, or poetry

Story text and pictures should be on one side of the paper and numbered on the back of each page

Stories should have a MINIMUM of 5 original, clear and colorful illustrations. Artwork can include drawings, photos, collages, and author-created 3D. Photos must be taken by the student author.

Story text may be printed, written legibly, or typed.

Children who cannot write may dictate their story to an adult. Invented spelling is accepted.

Each story needs to have the following parts to be complete:

*Official signed entry form page

*Title Page

*Story

Stories are due before Wednesday, April 16. A committee will select stories from each classroom that will go on to PBS 39. If you have questions, please contact your child's teacher.

Please note that seating for the concert will not be available before 3:00 pm.

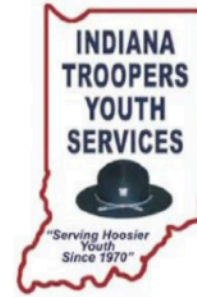
