About Voluntown

Located in the northeast corner of New London County on the border of Rhode Island, Voluntown is a picturesque rural community consisting of 39.8 square miles with two-thirds of the town made up of sprawling state forest. Voluntown was Incorporated in 1721 and has a rich history of textile mills, farming and agriculture, historic buildings, the Civilian Conservation Corps. (CCC Camp), folklore and was originally known as "Volunteer Town." The Voluntown Fire Department is still a volunteer-based organization.

The Town Hall is located in the Village Center, along with the pre-k-8 Voluntown Elementary School, Library, Constitution Field, walking track, gazebo, state-of-the-art playground and recreation courts. Nature lovers enjoy Pachaug State Forest which offers many outdoor activities. Voluntown boasts numerous riding trails and the state's only "horse camp." Beautiful Beach Pond offers boating and water sports, a public boat launch, and is annually stocked with fish by both Connecticut and Rhode Island.

The town has a vibrant Youth Service Bureau and a Recreation Commission, both of which develop positive programs that bring children, families, and the community together.
