Return to BHS Counselors BY FEBRUARY 8th

Students who have applied to attend BHS via [Choice Enrollment](#) will complete the registration process for BHS **AND** the school in their attendance area. BHS counselors will collect this form, however, **BHS classes cannot be entered in Infinite Campus until student is approved for enrollment at BHS.** *Current TMS students who do not live in the BHS attendance area are not "grandfathered" in (even if they have a sibling at BHS), the Choice Enrollment application MUST be submitted.*

➤➤ Choose courses & alternates wisely; staffing, master schedule, & class sizes are decided based on course requests, therefore:

- ~BHS cannot honor requests for specific teachers, off periods, or the availability of all electives.
- ~BHS counselors will prioritize using alternate course choices when there are schedule conflicts, however, your final schedule may have classes you did not request.
- ~BHS encourages all students to talk with their parents/guardians, current teachers, and counselor as they choose courses.
- ~Consider the extra time and commitment HONORS and STEM courses will require outside of class.
- ~Returning forms and entering classes in IC after **February 8th** can impact the courses available to you.
