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# Kindergarten Habitats

It's an exciting time of year for our Kindergarten students as they dive into the fascinating world of Earth's diverse habitats. They are learning about the unique plants and animals found in different environments in class, then visit the HUB to participate in hands-on challenges that reinforce their learning.



Recently, Kindergarteners began by exploring the Wetland habitat. They had the opportunity to create their own Great Blue Heron models, incorporating long legs and a beak that help them survive in their environment. Next, students studied desert habitats and were tasked with designing a shady shelter for Larry, a UV-sensitive lizard. To meet the challenge, students followed specific guidelines to build a structure that would allow Larry to crawl in and out, while also providing shade to protect him for the intense desert sun.
