GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility:

- The student must be a graduating senior from Lebanon High School.
- The student must prepare a brief application which states his/her identification, qualification, and to which field he/she plans to pursue. **All documentation must be complete and typed.**
***Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- The student must be enrolled **full-time** in the college, university or trade school they attend.

Requirements:

- Completed scholarship packet submitted **in this order.**
 - Application
 - Activities Chart - LSF Form 200
(Please summarize information. Only list things not on your transcript.)
 - Personal Statement (see application for details)
 - Unofficial transcript including 1st semester grades from 2024-25 school year
 - Page 1 of your 2025-2026 FAFSA Submission Summary, which includes your name and SAI (Student Aid Index). This report you receive after completing your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
 - Copy of acceptance letter to the college, university or trade school you will be attending.

Award:

- 1: Award payment made to college/university.
- 2: Unused portion will be returned to LSF if the school year is not completed.
- 3: Award may be deferred for one year (an additional year may be granted under special circumstances)
