English: 4 credits

Communications: .5 credit

## Society & Humanities:

Social Studies: 3.5 credits

Fine Arts: 1.0 credit



## STEM

Math: 4 credits

Science: 3 credits

STEM Elective: 1 credit (11th-12th)

## Employability and Life Skills:

Physical Education: 1 credit (9th)
