Orton-Gillingham Reading Instruction:**Entering 1st-6th Grade**

This 36 hour class is specifically designed to work with students with dyslexia or who struggle with reading. The Orton-Gillingham approach is designed to help struggling readers by explicitly teaching the connections between letters and sounds by using multisensory strategies paired with systematic, sequential lessons focusing on phonics. Instructors have been trained and certified in the Orton-Gillingham method of Reading. (Max Enrollment: 3 per class).

Reading, Writing and Arithmetic**Entering 1st-6th Grade**

This option is designed to improve and strengthen each child's skills in reading, writing and arithmetic. This program will individually evaluate reading and math abilities of each student and design a program specifically to each child's skills. A variety of tools may be used including: Sonday I & II, LiPS, The Phonics Program, Rite Flight Reading Fluency, Sound Reading Solutions, Earobics and HearBuilders. Orton-Gillingham strategies utilized in this program are proven to be effective with students with Dyslexia. Strategies for Study Success will be incorporated into the lessons along with FASTT Math (Fluency and Automaticity through Systematic Teaching and Technology). Other strategies will include sequencing activities and following directions to increase memory. These classes offer 30 hours of instruction. (Maximum Enrollment: 4 per class)
