# Managing Conflict with Empathy and Effectiveness

A four-week certificate course empowering staff to navigate conflict using relationships of influence, creating harmonious, accountable and respectful boarding house communities.

Conflict is a normal part of human relationships but often leads to communication breakdowns, damaged trust, and can impact individual wellbeing. Boarding staff face unique challenges with conflicts managing student and staff conflict, and traditional disciplinary methods can often fall short.

This course emphasises restorative practices, blending applied neuroscience, communication frameworks, and practical strategies. Participants will gain insights into human behaviour, self-regulation, and the causes of conflict, enabling them to manage high-tension situations with empathy and effectiveness. They'll also learn restorative dialogue techniques to rebuild trust and foster meaningful resolutions.

By the end of the course, staff will be equipped with tools such as coconstructed agreements, regulation strategies, and restorative problem-solving frameworks-ensuring collaborative and constructive conflict resolution.

Transform your approach to conflict and create a culture of respect, empathy, and accountability in your boarding community.


