- 1. September 5 meeting minutes unanimously approved
- 2. Principal Update- A) Positive feedback for Halloween parties and parades. B) Picture day photo proofs went home and December 9th is the makeup date. C) First school wide election held on November 5th. The goal was to teach why elections were important and introduce the structure of voting. Kids voted on a school wide reward of either indoor recess or karaoke. D) !st ever Veteran's Day celebration. E) Established the ACTIVE committee (Active Children Thrive In Vibrant Environments) which was awarded a grant. The funds will be used to purchase stencils in order to dress up the blacktop.
- 3. Review of school year up to date- The bookfair, Ice Cream Social, Gift of Time and Penny Wars had massive participation and exceeded our profit goals.
- 4. Budget Update- We have been under budget for our events and cleared our expected profit for everything except directories. The board unanimously voted to increase the PTO supply budget from \$100 to \$250 and to split the Lounge Upkeep budget with Snack Shack (\$100) and the rest (\$400) for Lounge UpKeep. The board unanimously voted to raise the Assembly budget from \$3,000 to \$5,000 earlier and the measure was unanimously passed by a 9 to 0 vote.
- 5. Committee Update- Afterschool programs: currently Mad Science and Baker's Dozen while field hockey and Spanish club are coming up. Family Movie Night: Happening December 13 at the middle school. We still need volunteers. We will be showing two short films (The Gruffalo's Child and The Snowy Day) instead of 1. Staff Luncheon: Happening 12/18 and we still need recess monitors. Volunteers will need to be independent volunteers. Boosterthon: We met our shirt sponsor minimum but still seeking more sponsorships.
