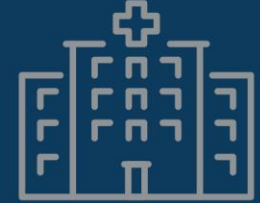

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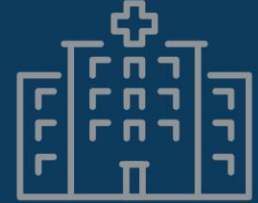


Highlights

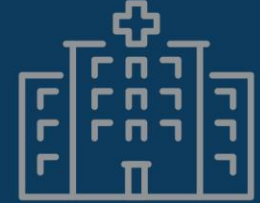
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Our Graduates

Rising Student Demand

- More than 25% of qualified applicants turned away
- Limited capacity

Growing Employer Demand

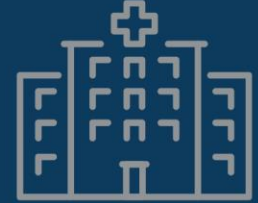
- Increasing need for skilled workers

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Feedback from District Voters

- Survey of 400 registered voters in the district
- Nov. 11-13, 2024



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Research Findings

- Top two voter concerns:
 - Education
 - Jobs and the economy
- 86% agree taxes paid to MNTC are a good investment
- 78% in support of \$85 million bond proposal

Most Important Skilled Training to Voters

- **Technical trades**

(e.g., construction, electrical, HVAC, CADD & AMT)

- **Health care**

(e.g., nursing, medical sonography, surgical technology, biomedical and physical therapy)

- Existing Health and IT building
- 100,000 sq. ft.

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Modernize and Equip

- Existing Main Building
 - Technical Trades
 - Business & IT
 - STEM

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Total Cost

- \$90 million
- 10-year obligation
- 1.25% property tax increase
- Approx. \$40 per year for average homeowner
