Dear Families,

As you review the February newsletter, you will discover a variety of significant and exciting events scheduled for this month. Special Person's Day is Friday, February 14th. As a reminder, this is an adult only event. Your student's special person must plan to attend the classroom time as well as lunch/recess. Student-led Conferences have been scheduled for February 5th, 6th and 7th, all are Early Release Days - 12:15 dismissal. Our students are busy preparing their leadership notebooks. Just as students track their goals, so is Mirada Leadership Academy. We have two academic WIGS (Wildly Important Goals) we are tracking each week. ELA GOAL - Each student will complete 45 minutes or more each week on Amplify through May 23, 2025. MATH GOAL - An average of 80% of students in grades K-2 will pass two (2) lessons or more on iReady each week and in grades 3-5, 80% of students will pass one (1) lesson or more on iReady each week through May 23, 2025. Take a look at our WIG Data Wall on the west side of the library. Ask your child about their progress with their goals. I think about Habit #2 and #3, both help us achieve our goals if we first begin with the end in mind and then put first things first. It is important to make a plan to help meet our goal and then commit to work before we play.

HABIT 6: SYNERGIZE

February 2025 | Kyrene de la Mirada

What is Habit 6: Synergize?

Synergize is the habit of creative cooperation. Synergizing is about teamwork, open-mindedness, and collaborating to find new solutions. Together, people can produce far better results than they could individually!

When people begin to interact together genuinely, and they are open to each other's influence, they begin to gain new insight.

Benefits of Synergy

- It helps us see things from different perspectives.
- It leads to more creative and effective results.
- It makes teamwork feel exciting and positive.

Signs of Synergy

- Feeling energized and excited about the outcome.
- Coming up with new ideas together.
- Finding solutions that are better than we originally thought.

Family Activity

- Use yellow food coloring in one cup of water and blue food coloring in another.
- Wet a paper towel and connect the two cups with it, creating a "bridge."
- Have your child predict what will happen when the two colors meet on the paper towel.
- After a few minutes, the colors mix in the middle of the towel and create a new color—green.
- Explain this is an example of a "third alternative" – individually, yellow and blue are nice, but together they form something new and better.



Dear Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade Families,

Mirada third, fourth, and fifth grade students will take Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) and fifth graders will also take the AZ Science

Assessment between the dates of **Monday, March 31st and Friday, April 18th.**

Please make note of the following specific testing dates to **avoid scheduling any appointments for your child(ren) during these days.** It is important for your child to be in attendance. However, it is more important that they are well and fever free. If you find your child has any symptoms that would not allow for them to come to school for the day, please make sure to call the attendance line at 480-541-4201 and report his or her absence. If your child begins the test, then becomes ill or exhibits symptoms that require them to be sent home, they will not be able to complete that section of the test or retake that section.

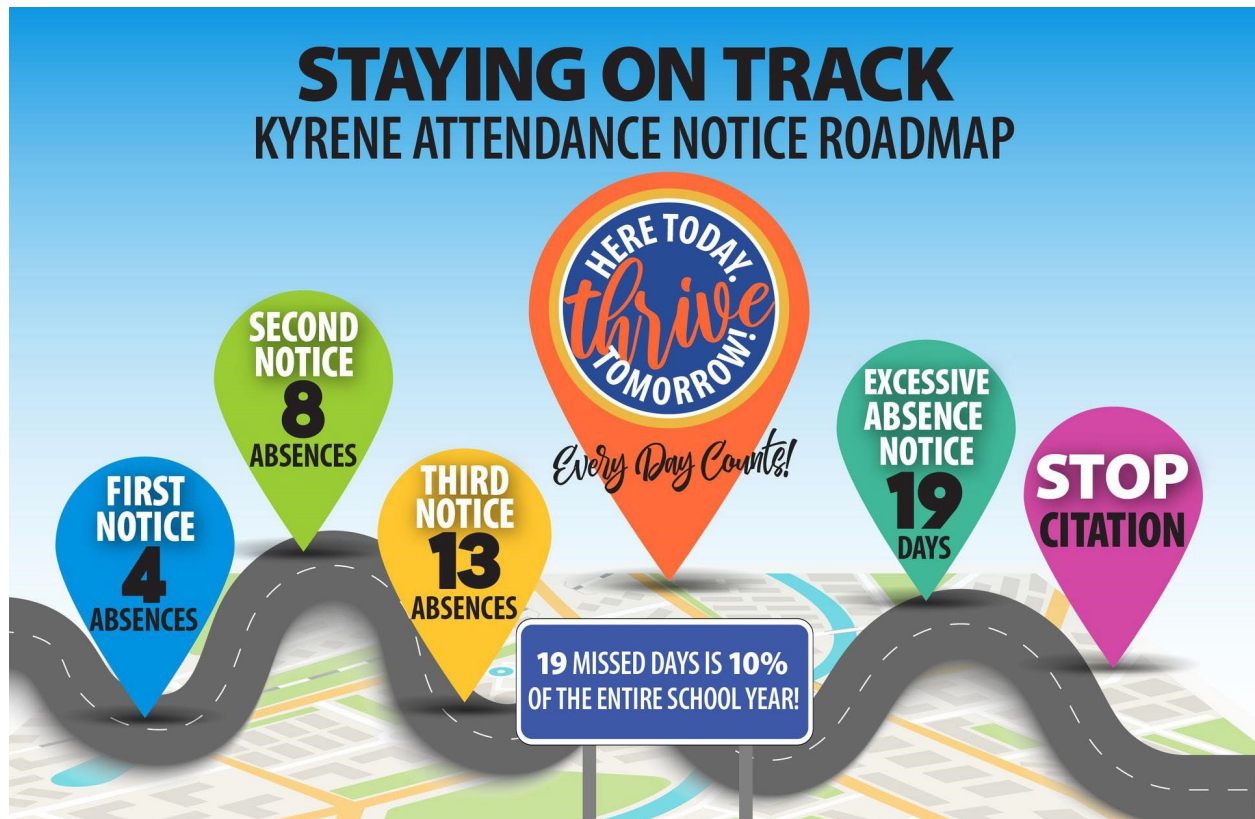

Attendance Notification Letters

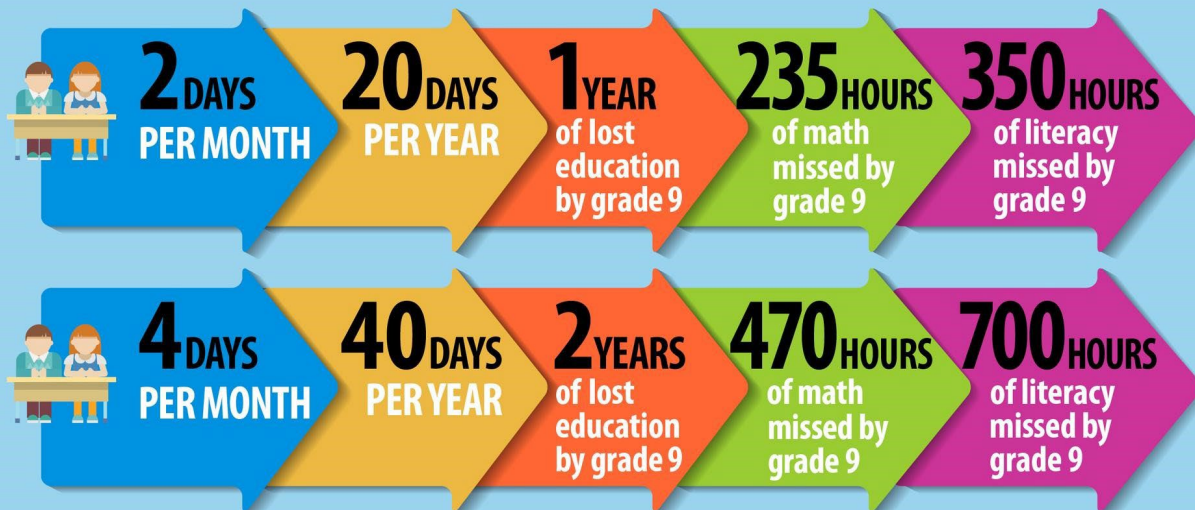
Dear families,

As we have shared in previous newsletters, we have been sending attendance letters when your child reaches 4, 8, and 13 absences. The purpose of this is to be proactive and keep you informed, so your children stay below 19 absences, which the state identifies as excessive. We understand that children get sick and family circumstances require your children to be absent from school. The portion of the letter that explains Arizona attendance law is required, but please know that our goal is always to support you and partner with you. Please reach out to our office staff if you have any questions.



ATTENDANCE IMPACT

When students are absent, they miss out on fundamental reading and math skills. This can impact grades and test performance. The graphic below shows how consistently missing days in grades K-8 can add up to years of lost education by high school.



Too sick for school?

Regular attendance is important for your child's well-being and learning. This guide can help you determine when to keep your child home and when to send them to school.



Send me to school if...

- I have a runny nose or mild cough, but **no** other symptoms.
- I have a mild rash but no other symptoms.
- I have only a mild stomachache.
- I have eye drainage but no fever, eye pain or redness.
- I haven't had a fever or taken any fever-reducing medicine for 24 hours.
- I haven't thrown up or had diarrhea for 24 hours.



Keep me at home if...

- I have a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees.
- I'm throwing up or have diarrhea.
- My eyes are pink and crusty.



Call the doctor if...

- I've had a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees for 2+ days or a fever combined with: *ear pain, sore throat, rash, cough, stomachache or headache.*
- I've been throwing up or have had diarrhea for more than two days.
- I've had the sniffles for more than a week, and they aren't getting better.
- I have any uncommon symptoms such as eye swelling or a rash with blisters



If you have specific concerns regarding your child's health or are worried your child will spread illness, contact your health care provider. This guide does not take the place of county or school district health guidance regarding respiratory viruses or other contagious illnesses.

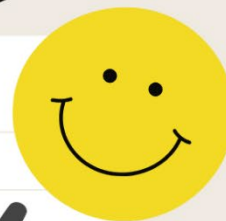

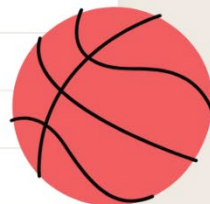

Parent Reminders

Opt in for text communication

IMPORTANT: In the event of an emergency, text messages are the fastest and most effective way to communicate information to families. You must opt in to receive text communications! Text “Y” or “yes” to 67587 to begin receiving text messages from both your child’s school and the Kyrene School District.

Birthday Celebrations

No celebrations of individual student birthdays are to be held in classrooms, on the school campus. We understand that parents and friends like to celebrate various occasions. However, cakes, cookies, cupcakes, candy, flowers, balloons, etc. cause many distractions and cannot be allowed on campus or on the bus. These items are disruptive in the classroom and are a safety concern on the bus. If they are delivered they will be kept in the office for parents/guardians to pick up. This policy helps to ensure that instructional time is protected and that all students are treated equally. **Party invitations may not be distributed at school.**

Need to Report an Absence?

Call our 24 Hour Attendance Line at 480-541-4201 to report a student absence.

Please leave a message on the attendance line indicating the student's name, grade, date(s) and reason for absence. When your student is absent and we have not received notification, we will contact the parents. If we do not receive a return phone call, the student will be marked truant.

****Note**** Parents MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if you spoke to the Health Office or communicated to the Teacher.

Tardy

If your child is tardy, you must park in the parking lot and walk your child to the office. Sign them in and provide the reason why they are tardy. A tardy is defined as arriving at school or class **after the scheduled start time**. Students should be in their seats and ready to learn when the bell rings at the scheduled start time. **Students are considered tardy if they are not in their seats at the scheduled start time. Mirada students need to arrive with enough time to make it to their classroom by 7:30am.** Students who are tardy must enter through the school’s front office and receive a Tardy pass.

Excused Absences

In cases involving prolonged illnesses, a written excuse from a physician may be requested to verify the absence. A student has an excused absence when one of the following conditions are met:

When a student is not in attendance for any portion of or an entire school day and,

- The parent/guardian called the school's attendance line to report the student's absence within 24 hours and provided an acceptable excuse* for the absence, OR
- The parent/guardian was reached by the attendance office and provided the attendance office with an acceptable excuse* for the absence.

***Please note: we cannot excuse an absence that is reported via email; all absences must be reported to the school's attendance office via a telephone call.**

Unexcused Absences

A student has an unexcused absence under and of the following conditions:

- When a student is not in attendance for any portion of or for an entire day and does not have an acceptable excuse*.
- The parent/guardian has not called the school's attendance office to report the student's absence and provide an acceptable excuse* within 24 hours.
- The parent/guardian cannot be reached by the attendance office to obtain an acceptable excuse* for the absence.

*The District will report all student absences and tardiness to school in accordance with A.R.S. § 15-901 (A)(1) and defined by the Arizona Department of Education.

Students and Electronic Devices

Many parents choose to have their child carry a cellular telephone or other electronic devices (such as an Apple watch or Fitbit) as a means of before and/or after school communication and for safety purposes. Electronic devices can be disruptive in an educational environment, but may also be used to enhance instruction. If parents have decided that it's necessary for a child to carry a cell phone or electronic device, parents and students must be aware of the following:

Kyrene School District Policy 3-401 states that the District does not assume responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, personal property. If your child has a cell phone on campus or on the bus and it is damaged or stolen, we will not be able to utilize administrative time to investigate the incident, nor will the District be able to take any financial responsibility for the cell phone or cell phone charges.

Cellular phones must be turned off and kept in backpacks at all times on campus, except for prior to the ringing of the first bell for the start of the instructional day and after the ringing of the last bell for the end of the instructional day.

This exception does not apply if the student is on the school bus. When appropriate, cell phones and other electronic devices may be used during the school day under the direct supervision of the teacher. If these rules are not followed, the cell phone may be confiscated and kept in the front office for pick up after school.

Please assist us in keeping our learning environment free from distractions. When it is necessary for a student to contact you during the day, we have telephones available in classrooms and in the office. If it is necessary for you to get an important message to your child during the school day, you may contact the school office and our staff will relay the message to your child.
