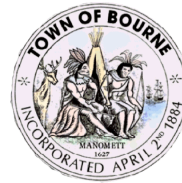

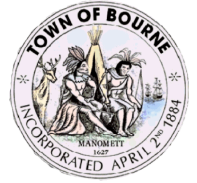
Called to order at 12:30. Adjourned at 1:45.

1. Minutes from 3/31/2021 approved.
2. Curriculum Updates
 - a. Major Resource Teach History & Social Studies to support 2018 Frameworks
Various companies have come and shared their materials
No one resource satisfies Grades K-12
K-5 looking at adopting "Inquiry Journeys"- inquiry based units
Grades 6-12 looking at DBQ (Document Based Questions)
Both resources complements the Civic Action Piece in Grades 6,8,10
 - b. Financial Literacy Curriculum Grant
Applied as a high school-awarded \$10,000-will pay for summer work for 2 teachers and potential community partnerships; possibly expanding to 12th grade internships
 - c. Summer Curriculum Teams: goal is to look at skill gaps rather than content gaps and make adjustments to scope and sequence
Elem: recalibrating ARC using Benchmark results
Secondary: Vertical work on DBQs; looking at texts with consideration of inclusion/equity
 - d. MTSS Math & Literacy Institutes
Math K-12: 14 people team took an 8 week course; a second course may be offered in fall; a teacher is taking the training course so she can train our staff;
Literacy Institute:
elementary teams are creating a digital notebook of interventions;
secondary teams are breaking down ELA standards and seeing how they fit into other subj.
a teacher is taking the training course as well; monthly webinars for administrators
3. Update on Summer Acceleration Academies; transportation being provided
 - a. BMS looking at potentially failing or disengaged students in ELA/Math and strongly suggesting they participate in a 4wk/4days/week 9-12 program using DESE prioritized standards;
 - b. BHS failing students being offered help to recover their credits in Math, ELA, Science, history;
 - c. Elementary Academy K-5 being offered to specific students based on EOY benchmarks in ELA/Math during the first two weeks in August 8:30-12:30.
 - d. Additionally ILC students will be offered their Extended School Year program, the Rec Dept. is offering their Slide into Learning session for grades K-2 students, and tutoring is being offered to specific students. A brochure will be coming out explaining all the options available.
