### Principal's Message

Winter Parent/Teacher conferences are February 3-7. If your child's teacher has reached out to you to schedule a conference, please make it a priority to attend. Your presence is a critical piece in our three-way partnership to ensure your child's growth and success.

In just two short months we will start our yearly state testing known as the Smarter Balance Assessments (SBAC). Students in 3rd-6th grade participate in this test to assess their proficiency in reading and math. Our 5th graders also take the state science test (CAST). Now is the time to start preparing your child for this important time in the school year where they "show what they know".

Some ways you can support at home are as follows:

- Make sure your child is on time for school. Tardies mean a loss of instructional minutes in the area of reading or math, which could make them fall behind.
- Work with the teacher to determine specific areas your child may need support in and make a plan to practice and fine tune these skills at home.
- If they took the state test last year, review their score on Aeries and set a goal for improvement. Teachers are also doing this in class.
- Set high expectations and goals at home and include rewards for reaching their goals.

Over the next two months, students will be taking practice interim tests and will be talking through testing strategies in the classroom as well.

Finally, This month we are focusing on INTEGRITY. We will spend time reviewing the importance of standing by your word and being honest even when it's hard. 

### **RACE Strategy**

In our efforts to improve student comprehension and writing skills, our fifth and sixth grade students specifically learn and practice the RACE strategy.

The short response strategy is as follows:

- 1. **R**estate the Question Turn the question into a statement.
- 2. **A**nswer the Question Answer all parts of the question.
- 3. **C**ite your Evidence Choose a quote from the text to support your answer.
- 4. Explain your Answer Explain, expand, and elaborate on your answer, so you connect the dots between your answer and the text evidence

This strategy allows students to develop a deeper understanding of what is learned and reinforces the importance of answering in complete sentences. I highly recommend practicing this strategy at home.

Parents can ask while reviewing student homework:

- How do you know that is correct?
- Where did you find that in the text?
- (In Math) Show me the work you did to come up with this answer. Did you check your answer?
