Dear Driver Education Student/Parent:

The following letter contains information on the Enderlin Driver Education program. State guidelines require thirty classroom hours, six hours behind-the-wheel, and six hours of observation for students wishing to get a behind-the-wheel certificate and ¼ credit on their high school transcript. A letter grade and 1/4 credit will be given to pupils that complete/pass the course. The class is not required to graduate from the Enderlin Area School. Therefore, it is not mandatory for students to take the course.

After completing the course, students receive a certificate of completion or a certificate of training, that will allow them the opportunity to get their driver license or test for their driver's license at age 15. Students with permits will be eligible for the completion certificate, which skips the driving test at the DMV, if they check all the boxes during the behind the wheel portion of the class. They must be at least 14 years of age to drive with the instructor, a permit is not mandatory. If the student does not have a permit, they are not eligible for the "completion" certificate, just the training certificate. Teens 14 years of age that have a permit will be required to hold that permit for a minimum of 12 months before they get their license. Teens 15 years of age will be required to hold the permit until age 16 or a minimum of six months, whichever is longer.

Permit tests can be taken online at home or at the DMV, please contact Mr. Kraft if you have any questions on how to do it either way.

Pupils who currently have permits will be given the opportunity to drive first whenever possible. Students do not need a permit to take the behind-the-wheel portion, but it is **RECOMMENDED** having one to be eligible for the completion certificate.
