Disciplining a 504 Student with Disabilities

What is the discipline process for a 504 student with disabilities?

Section 504 students with disabilities are subject to the same disciplinary action as students without disabilities, provided that the student's behavior is <u>not</u> a manifestation of his or her qualifying disability. A 504 Team must conduct a manifestation determination whenever a student with disabilities is subject to out-of-school suspension for 10 consecutive school days or more, or if multiple short-term suspensions would result in a significant change in placement. If the 504 Team concludes that the violation is a manifestation of the student's qualifying disability, the discipline process must end, and the 504 Team should review the 504 Plan to determine if changes are appropriate. If the violation is not a manifestation, the student is subject to the same disciplinary action that any student without disabilities would receive for the same violation.
