### **SUMMER 2025**

Registration begins March 4 at 6 a.m. for Summer Kidstop. Program dates will be June 13-August 15. The deadline to make any changes to your contracts is 11:59 p.m. on May 1, 2025. Any changes after this date will have additional fees.

Contracts will remain pending until the week of March 24, 2025, at this time we will begin accepting contracts in the order they are submitted based on our current staffing levels. This will continue to change as new staff are hired into the program, if needed, waiting list communication will be sent the week of April 14, 2025 if your contract has not been accepted by that week.

### **REGISTRATION FEES**

Registration requires a non-refundable registration fee per student. Registration fees are not processed until the contract is accepted.

Registration completed by 3/18/2025 is a \$35 per student fee. Any registration completed after this date is \$45.00 per student fee.

Registration fees are non-refundable.

An email confirmation will be sent to account owners when the contact is accepted, starting the week of March 24.

## SUMMER COMMITMENT DEADLINE MAY 1, 2025 AT 11:59 p.m.

### Any changes made to your contract before May 1 at 11:59 p.m. can include:

- Unlimited contract changes including adding or removing days with no fees attached (minimum of 20 days required for a summer contract).
- Summer Contracts can be withdrawn by this date to avoid a withdrawal fee of up to \$955.00.

### Any changes made after the May 1 at 11:59 p.m. can deadline include:

Withdrawing from the program will result in a \$35.00 withdrawal fee per child along with paying for the 20 day minimum requirement of \$920 per child. Drop in days do not count towards your 20 day minimum.

Add drop in days for \$56.00 per day. Adding days is not guaranteed due to space and programming availability. Drop in days need to be added by entering it in through the online registration by Wednesday at 11:59 p.m., prior to the week attending.

Cancel days for a fee of \$35.00 per child per email request. Canceling a day requires email notification to be sent to CECares@district279.org by Wednesday at 11:59 p.m. prior to the affected week. Days cannot be canceled if it reduces your contract under the 20 day minimum.

 We do not allow swapping, trading, moving, banking or sick days in our program. Your tuition is due regardless of your students' attendance.

## PROGRAM EXPERIENCES INCLUDE

Osseo Area Schools Community Education's Kidstop Program offers an exciting and engaging summer care experience for students entering grades K-5. Our program features enriching activities, choice-based opportunities that foster and inspire individual interests. Students can also enjoy community based field trips, providing exploration opportunities to connect in other surroundings.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Students engage in choice-based programming and choose how they want to spend their day.
- Students are grouped with similar ages (K-1, 2-3, 4-5).
- Student to staff ratios are one staff for every 15 students for grades 2-5 and one staff for every 12 students in K-1.
