THIS WEEK'S TOP STORIES

September Focus: Teamwork and October Focus: Integrity

In September, our school focused on **Teamwork**, emphasizing key traits from the 42 Developmental Assets that shape students into well-rounded community members. We highlighted Asset #9: **Service to Others**, Asset #26: **Caring**, and Asset #33: **Interpersonal Competence**. These traits encourage students to build strong relationships and positively contribute to their school and community. As we move into October, we are shifting our focus to **Integrity**, which is Asset #28. Research shows that students who develop these assets are better equipped to handle conflicts peacefully, make thoughtful decisions, avoid risky behaviors, and show resilience in the face of challenges.

Diagnostic Assessments and Intervention Groups

Throughout September, students completed diagnostic assessments to identify their strengths and areas for growth. Teachers are now reviewing this data to create personalized intervention groups, which will begin on **October 7** for all students. These groups will target specific skills and provide focused support where it's needed most. Additionally, the data is being used to organize academic support sessions with **Ms. Gabriel** in the **Title 1** program to enhance student achievement. Parents will receive assessment data along with interim reports, and teachers will discuss the results during **Parent-Teacher Conferences on October 3 and 4**.



Hydroponics Initiative

Throughout October, students will dive into learning about the plant life cycle through interactive activities in their classrooms. This hands-on experience will allow students to explore sustainable growing techniques and gain a deeper understanding of biology.
