## Health Services

### Kindergarten Health Requirements for School Entry 2025-2026

Per Board of Education Policy 7:100, all students must meet the health requirements as outlined by the Illinois Department of Public Health. All requirements must be in place before school entry. For health and safety reasons, students that are non-compliant will be excluded from school on or before October 15<sup>th</sup> of the current school year, no appointment cards will be accepted. New students who register after October 15 of the current school year shall have 30 days following registration to comply with the health examination and immunization regulations.

1. Physical exams dated **on or after August 13, 2024** will be accepted and are due on the first day of school.
  - **Health Examination:** conducted within one year prior to the date of entry, is **required**.
  - **Health History Section** must be completed and **signed by the parent or legal guardian**. *This is required.*
  - **Lead Assessment** documentation, indicating the healthcare provider has addressed the lead poisoning questionnaire is **required**.
  - **Diabetes Risk Questionnaire** is completed if BMI for age is >85%.
2. **Immunizations:** Month/day/year and correct number of doses at the correct intervals must be verified by a healthcare provider. **Immunizations are required as follows for Kindergarten entry:**
  - **DTaP:** 4 or more doses of DTaP, at appropriate intervals, with the last dose being a booster and given on or after the 4th Birthday.
  - **POLIO:** 4 or more doses at the appropriate intervals with the last dose being a booster and given on or after the 4th birthday.
  - **MMR:** 2 doses; 1st dose on or after first birthday, second dose given at least 28 days later.
  - **VARICELLA (Chicken Pox):** 2 doses: 1st dose on or after first birthday, second dose given at least 28 days later or confirmation of chickenpox disease.
  - **Hepatitis B:** Three doses of Hepatitis B administered at appropriate intervals.
3. **Dental Examination:** DENTAL EXAMINATION is due on or before May 15, 2026. Dental exams dated on or after November 15, 2024 will be accepted.
4. **Eye Examination:** All students enrolling in Kindergarten and any student enrolling for the first time in a public, private, or parochial school are required to have an eye exam. The exam must be completed by an optometrist or ophthalmologist.
